Action Requested: Please review Registrant's comments to Agency's toxicological evaluation/setting of RfD and subsequent denial of requested import tolerance on dried and spent hops; determine if RfD should be reevaluated.

Comment: This appears to be the same submission that was forwarded to TB II earlier (HED Project # 1-1060; Date In: 4/11/91). The current submission (HED Project # 1-1184, Date In: 5/3/91) differs from the previous one as follows:

The supplement to the 30-day study (5 pages in the HED Project # 1-1060) contains only 4 pages (pages 4 and 5 are missing and

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there are two page 2). Additionally, the EPA MRID No. is 41775501). In HED Project # 1-1060, the MRID No. is 41775201. Note: The # is hand-written and a "5" appears to have been changed to a "2"; on the bean sheet, the number is listed as 41715201.

TB II suggests that only one MRID # be associated with this submission to avoid confusion in the future.
