Request:

The Exposure Assessment Branch has requested that the Toxicology Branch determine the need for a human, nondietary exposure assessment for the Sulfotepp Registration Standard.

Response:

Sulfotepp is one of the impurities of Diazinon. From the Diazinon data, the Toxicology Branch is aware that Sulfotepp is highly toxic. However, we currently have no data on Sulfotepp. Therefore, at this time we cannot determine the need for a human, nondietary exposure assessment for Sulfotepp.
