Registration Division has asked OREB to establish a Worker Protection Standard (WPS) interim restricted entry interval (REI) for deltamethrin. Deltamethrin was registered last year for an indoor use, and is in the process of being registered for a food use. Deltamethrin was not on the active ingredient list in PR Notice 93-7 Supplement 3-A that listed WPS REIs.

The WPS REIs are based on the acute toxicity of the technical grade product. Table one lists the acute toxicity for deltamethrin (personal communication with John Doherty, 6/1/95, TB I).

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TABLE ONE: ACUTE TOXICITY OF DELTAMETHRIN	
Tox Test	Tox Category
Acute oral	II
Acute Dermal	III
Acute Inhalation	III
Primary Eye Irritation	III
Primary Dermal Irritation	IV
Dermal Sensitization	No

Please note the Data Evaluation Record included in the BEAN packet listed the acute oral tox category as III, it is actually a category II.

For the purpose of setting an interim REI, the WPS states that the following acute tox categories must be considered: acute dermal, and primary eye and primary dermal irritation. The most toxic applicable tox category is used to determine the REI. For deltamethrin it is tox category III.

CONCLUSIONS:

OREB establishes the WPS interim REI for deltamethrin at 12 hours since it is a category III compound for the applicable tox categories.
