Dear Mr. Gordon:

This refers to Pasticide Petition No. 900821 for which temporary tolerances for residues of the barbicide RH-315 (3,5-dichloro-H-(1,1-dimethyl-2-propynyl)bensomide) and its metabolites (calculated as the parent compound) on a variety of raw agricultural commodities were established on August 29, 1969.

In the event that you should consider proposing permanent tolerances for residues of RH-315 and its metabolites in the future, the following additional data will be needed before we will be able to give consideration to such a proposal:

- The residue data submitted for clover reflects only one location, namely Pennsylvania. We will need additional data for clover reflecting broader geographical representation.
- No residue data were presented for laspedeza, trefoil, nor vetch.
  We will need data for these three communities.
- 3. The residue data submitted for lettuce was sufficient for the temporary telerance. Additional data for lettuce from other geographical areas, and for the Celmar variety data reflecting treatment-harvest intervals of less than 40 days.
- 4. In the event tolerances are proposed on poultry feed items, a poultry feeding study will be necessary to determine what residual levels, if any, would result in poultry tissue end/or eggs from the feeding of treated crops to poultry.

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5. Additional data pertaining to soil persistence in representative soil types will be needed.
