Division of Pesticide's memorandum of June 9, 1969, paragraph #1 under Recommendations, asks DPT's opinion about the need for positive identification in respect to metabolites 6, 7, and 8 of RH-315 in alfalfa. Since plant, rat, and cow metabolism is similar and the method would be expected to determine these metabolites and that meat and milk residues would not be expected to occur from recommended uses of RH-315, we conclude that further identification of these metabolites is not needed.
