Action Requested: The registrant, DowElanco, has submitted materials in support of a Section 3 Registration as a "Reduced Risk" pesticide. The package included: 1) a revised request to waive toxicology data, 2) an FQPA Informative Summary, and 3) a developmental toxicity study in rabbits and a multigeneration reproductive toxicity study in rats.

Response: After a cursory review of the developmental toxicity and the multigeneration reproductive toxicity studies, there is no indication that hexaflumuron has an adverse effect on fetal development, fertility, or reproductive performance. [Note: OECD Data on developmental and reproductive toxicity studies accepted previously by the Agency also support this finding.] In addition, the request for the data waivers for the other toxicology data requirements (acute toxicity, delayed neurotoxicity, subchronic and chronic toxicity studies) has been adequately supported by the registrant. Therefore, HED recommends granting the request in support of the Section 3 registration as a "Reduced Risk" pesticide.



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
