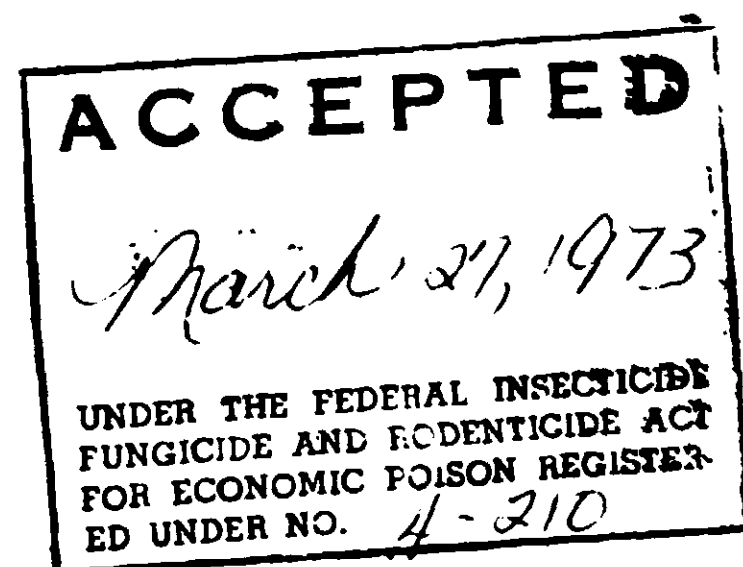

Just punch out 1 or 2 sifter openings and dust on undesirable lawn weeds, such as dandelions, buckhorn, burdock, plantains and certain other weeds. May cause injury on bentgrass, St. Augustine grass, Dichondra, carpetgrass, or clover lawns.

SHAKE CAN TO FLUFF POWDER — Use this package as a duster. Punch out one or two openings and press sides of container with fingers, using rapid motion.

DIRECTIONS

Choose a warm, calm day to apply so as to prevent wind drift of the chemical onto desirable plants, flowers, vegetables, etc. Can be applied any time when weeds are growing, preferably when dew is present.

Apply dust lightly on the leaves of the weeds to be killed. Avoid overdose, as temporary injury to surrounding grass may result.

Weeds die within 2 to 4 weeks. The more resistant types may require a second treatment one month following the first treatment. In all cases repeat treatment as needed.

CAUTION: Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing.

Do not store near fertilizers, seeds, insecticides or fungicides.

Do not reuse container. Destroy when empty.

Do not contaminate water used for irrigation or domestic purposes.

Do not apply to newly seeded lawns.

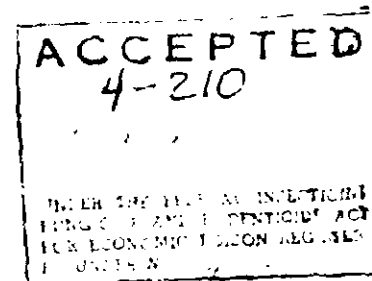

SHAKE CAN TO FLUFF POWDER — Use this package out one or two openings and press sides of container rapid motion.

DIRECTIONS

Choose a warm, calm day to apply so as to prevent chemical onto desirable plants, flowers, vegetables, any time when weeds are growing, preferably when dry.

Apply dust lightly on the leaves of the weeds to be killed as temporary injury to surrounding grass may result.

Weeds die within 2 to 4 weeks. The more resistant to second treatment one month following the first treatment repeat treatment as needed.

CAUTION: Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Do not store near fertilizers, seeds, insecticides or flammable liquids. Do not reuse container when empty. Do not contaminate water used for irrigation or domestic use. Do not apply to newly seeded lawns.
