The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the tetramethrin and permethrin REDs, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is <u>not</u> being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time.

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156.140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on non-refillable containers. The code may appear either on the label or durably marked on the container itself, and can be added by non-notification per PRN 98-10.

For best results, use this product early in the morning or at dusk when insects are less active. Spray at a safe distance from the nest and do not stand directly underneath it. To kill the entire nest, spray until it is soaked. Wait at least 24 hours before removing the nest. Aim the can away from you while spraying. If it

Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter the treated area until sprays have dried. Do not apply this product in a way that will contact adults, children, or pets, either directly or through drift.

For Outdoor Use: Do not water the treated area to the point of run-off. Do not make applications during rain. All outdoor applications must be limited to spot or crack-and-crevice treatments only. Application is prohibited directly into sewers or drains, or to any area like a gutter where drainage to sewers, storm drains, water bodies, or aquatic habitat can occur. Do not allow the product to enter any drain during or after application.

TO KILL Wasps, Hornets, Mud Daubers, Yellow Jackets and Bees [including Carpenter Bees] under eaves, screens, window frames, doors, patios, cracks, holes or crevices wherever insects are noticed, directly spray insects for about 1-2 seconds.

This product may also be used indoors, in areas such as attics or crawl spaces where insects build nests. Whenever used indoors, follow directions for use carefully. Once nest is treated, leave the area quickly and close door behind you. Do not re-enter area for at least 24 hours to ensure all insects are killed.

Specific Instructions

TO KILL **Wasps:** Treatments should be made at dusk or early morning when insects are least active. Shake can and hold upright, pointing valve toward nest with wind at back.

TO KILL **Hornets:** Hornets make their nests in trees and shrubs and under eaves. Do not treat hornet's nests unless you can clearly see the entrance hole at the base. Wait until dusk or early morning when wasps are at rest. Direct spray into entrance hole and continue to spray into nest as wasps fall out until can is empty or no more wasps are seen. Leave area quickly.

TO KILL **Yellow Jackets:** Yellow jackets make their nests in tree stumps, walls, railroad ties or similar structures. Watch for wasp activity during the day to locate nest location. Treat at dusk or early morning when insects are at rest. Empty entire contents of can into nest hole from close range to ensure product enters entrance hole and leave area immediately.

TO KILL Bees (including Carpenter Bees): Spray around points of the home where insects enter such as outside plumbing, faucets, cracks or crevices in foundation, under eaves, and along sills and ledges.

TO KILL **Mud Daubers:** Treatments should be made at dusk or early morning when insects are least active. Shake can and hold upright, pointing valve toward nest with wind at back. Spray directly on insects and their nests.

To **Tent Caterpillars:** Make applications when caterpillars are young and tents are first noticed (usually late spring). For best results, apply in the late afternoon or evening when caterpillars have returned to their tents. Aim spray directly at tents, and totally saturate on all sides.

TO KILL Gypsy Moth Caterpillars: Make applications when caterpillars are young and first noticed (usually late spring). Spray plants evenly to the point of run-off, applying to both sides of leaves and other areas of plants where insects are suspected. For dense evergreens and shrubs, be sure spray reaches interior leaves and branches.

Do not apply to pets or contaminate feed, foodstuffs, dishes or utensils. Avoid spraying vegetation directly.

NOTE: This product is non-staining to most building siding depending on age and condition. Before using in areas where this product may contact siding, test in an inconspicuous area, then check back in a few hours.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage and disposal.
