Submission dated August 20, 2003, acceptable with comments.

Dear Mr. McEntee:

The revised labeling referenced above, submitted in connection with the registration under the Federal Insecticide, fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA) as amended, is acceptable with the following comments:

- 1) Delete on page 3 the Preharvest and Grazing Restrictions that address plant rotational food, reclamation of irrigation water and (?) grazing of dairy and meat animals which are more applicable for agricultural use products.
- 2) Add to the Precautionary Statements "Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. Remove contaminated clothing and wash clothing before reuse".
- 3) Delete under the Directions for Use the "Do not apply this product in a way that will contact workers......either directly or through drift" since it is more applicable to agricultural products than to homeowners products.
- 4) Delete Amblyomma spp from the Lyme Disease section since it has not been found to be a carrier of the disease.
- 5) The Directions for Use "For plants above chest height....." does not appear to be necessary for granular formulation applied to the ground and may be deleted.
- 6) Delete "for terrestrial uses" from the Environmental Hazards since only terrestrial uses are listed.

FIRST AID

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IF INHALED:

Move person to fresh air.

If person is not breathing, call 911, or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth to mouth, if possible.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN

Carbaryl is a N-methyl carbamate insecticide, which is a cholinesterase inhibitor. Atropine is antidotal. Narcotics and other sedatives should not be used. Further, drugs like 2-PAM (pyridine-2-aldoxime methiodide) are NOT recommended.

Consultation on diagnosis, therapy and analysis can be obtained at all hours by calling the emergency number.

GENERAL CAUTIONS AND RESTRICTIONS

EASY GARDEN Granular Carbaryl Insecticide is a granular formulation of Carbaryl which may be applied by ground equipment.

Apply when air is calm to avoid drift and contact with skin and eyes.

For plants above chest height, consider using a liquid Carbaryl product.

Do not repeat applications more than once per week.

PLANT RESPONSE PRECAUTIONS

Application to wet foliage or during periods of high humidity may cause injury to tender foliage.

PREHARVEST AND GRAZING RESTRICTIONS AND LIMITATIONS

Tolerances established under the Federal Food, Drug and Cosmetic Act permit the sale of labeled crops bearing probable Carbaryl residues when this product is used in accordance with the label directions. If used as directed, treated forage may be grazed or used as feed for dairy and meat animals without causing illegal residues in meat or milk. Do not apply at greater rates or at more frequent intervals than stated on the label. To do so may result in illegal residues in crops, meat, and milk.

Do not use reclaimed irrigation water from crops treated with Carbaryl on crops for which Carbaryl tolerances are not established.

Do not plant rotational food and feed crops not listed on this or other Carbaryl labels in Carbaryl treated soil.

APPLICATION STATEMENT

Calibrate and adjust application equipment to insure proper rate and accurate placement.

TURFGRASS

For control of turfgrass pests, apply granules uniformly to dry turfgrass. For optimum control, follow specific directions for proper application and irrigation.

RESTRICTIONS AND LIMITATIONS: TURFGRASS

DO NOT ALLOW PUBLIC USE OF TREATED AREAS DURING APPLICATION.

CONTROL OF TICKS WHICH VECTOR LYME DISEASE

For control of juvenile and adult *Ixodes spp.* ticks (Deer tick, Bear tick, and Black legged tick) and *Amblyomma spp.* ticks (Lone star tick). Apply granules at the rate of 2.5 to 3.0 pounds of formulated product per 1000 square feet.

Begin applications in late spring or early summer (May/June). Apply the recommended amount of product uniformly across the entire lawn, perimeter wooded areas, and property boundaries including shrub beds, ornamental plantings, and wooded areas where exposure to ticks may occur. For optimum results, irrigate treated areas after application to remove chemical from granules.

FIRE ANTS

For use as a mound treatment to control fire ants, apply 1.5 to 3.0 ounces by weight over and around each fire ant mound. Thoroughly irrigate mound immediately after treatment to remove the chemical from the granules and flush it down into the mound. A minimum of 1 gallon of water should be applied to each mound, but do not use more than 2 gallons of water as flooding of the mound may result. Apply water gently to avoid disturbing ants and causing migration before chemical can be effective. For best results, apply in the early morning or late evening hours when ants are least active. Treat new mounds as they appear.

NUISANCE PEST CONTROL IN VEGETABLES AND SMALL FRUITS (NOT FOR USE IN CALIFORNIA)

For control of Ants, Centipedes, Crickets, Cutworms, Earwigs, Grasshoppers, Millipedes, Sowbugs (Pillbugs), Springtails, and Ticks, apply Easy Garden Carbaryl Granules evenly over the soil surface. Water lightly after application to release the chemical from the granules. Applications may be made at any time before, during or after the growing season except as indicated in the specific directions for asparagus. Do not use on crops other than those listed below. Observe the pre-harvest intervals* for applications during the growing season:
