## CAUTION

It is used on all types of dressed lumber, including sash, doors, screens, trim, beams and structural siding. Bar D-K can be painted over with any oil paint or stain and it meets the specifications of the National Door Manufacturers Association and the Western Pine Association. Contains 5% of technical Pentachlorophenol as defined in Federal Specifications.

## **DIRECTIONS**

- 1. Apply to new wood or to wood from which all previous finishes have been removed. Wood should be clean and dry. However, a treatment of Bar D-K to green or wet lumber will reduce its tendency to check, split and warp as it dries. Should be applied as it comes from the container. No thinning or heating is required.
- 2. For best results lumber after it is machined, cut and sended should be immersed in a tank of Bar D-K. If this is not practical then Dar D-K should be sprayed or bruched on liberally; especially on end grain where moisture and water enter most readily.
- 3. Doors, windows, screens, flooring-and other solid dressed lumber should be immersed in Bar D-K for three minutes or be treated with a liberal application by brush or spray.
- 4. Sheathing, studs, joists and sub-flooring should be immersed for at least 25 minutes. If this is not practical two applications by brush or spray are recommended.
- 5. For fence posts or timbers which are not to be painted and are going into the ground we recommend a treatment with Cabot's Conservo, a highly refined Crossote Oil.
- 6. Before painting or varnishing wood treated with Bar D-K should be allowed to dry overnight.

COVERING CAPACITY — APPROXIMATE: 200 square feet per gallon — one coat, 1000 board feet of 1" lumber — 7 to 8 gallons; 1000 board feet of 2" lumber — 3 to 4 gallons; 45 Standard size window sash — 1 gallon. These quantities are based on a 3 minute dip.
