General Information

Tolban 4E is a selective herbicide which when mixed into the soil before re-planting will provide residual control of certain annual grasses and broadleaf weeds (see list). It controls weeds as they germinate. It does not control established weeds.

Incorporation of Tolban 4E into the top 2-3 inches of soil in the final seedbed is necessary to assure effective weed control regardless of weather conditions. Later, rotary-hoeing, shallow cultivation, shallow ditching for irrigation, or hand-hoeing can be carried out as needed without reducing weed control.

Application

Thoroughly mix crop residues into soil to a depth of 4-6 inches by deep plowing or disking prior to application.

Apply with a properly calibrated low-pressure sprayer. Add Tolban 4E to clean water while filling the spray tank. Uniformly apply the recommended rate in 10-40 quarts of water per acre.

Apply to the soil surface and incorporate in the same operation, if possible, to assure maximum herbicidal activity. If not incorporated during application, Tolban 4E should be applied to a dry, loose soil surface and incorporated within 4 hours.

Delayed incorporation may result in poor weed control, especially if Tolban 4E is applied to a wet, warm surface, or when the wind speed is more than 10 mph. Also, shallow incorporation (less than 2 inches deep) may result in variable weed control.

Do not apply Tolban 4E with any of the following:

• Disk harrow set to cut 4 inches deep and operated in two different directions at 5-8 mph.

• 2 Rolling cultivator set to cut 2-4 inches deep and operated two times at 6-8 mph. Use on coarse and medium-textured soils.

• Multi-treader and other similar disk-type implement set to cut 3-4 inches deep and operated in two different directions at 5-8 mph.

• 4 PTO-driven equipment (tiller, cultivator, or hoe) set to cut 2-3 inches deep and operated one time at less than 4 mph.

• 5 Bed conditioner set to cut 2-4 inches deep and operated one time at 4-6 mph. Use only on coarse and medium-textured soils.

As an alternative to the above surface application followed by incorporation, Tolban may be applied beneath the soil surface with a spray blade, such as a Stoneville blade or other layering techniques set at about 1-2 inches deep.

Directions for Use

Alfalfa (seedling), cotton, dry beans, kidney beans, navy, pinto, garbanzo peas, chickpeas, guar, mung beans, okra, safflower, snap beans (green, wax, string), southern peas (cowpeas, blackeye peas), soybeans, and sunflowers.

Apply before planting at the rate recommended in the following table in 10-40 quarts of water per acre, and incorporate

within 4 hours. Where a range of rates is given, use the higher rate if the soil texture, organic matter, or greater than 25% of the weeds present are difficult to control. If a heavy weed population is expected:

Note: Do not use for weed control in alfalfa in Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Michigan, Minnesota, Montana, North Dakota, or South Dakota.

*For band treatment the amount of Tolban 4E required may be calculated by the formula:

Precaution: Do not use Tolban 4E for weed control in alfalfa if a nurse crop such as oats is to be planted or if an alfalfa-grass mixture is to be seeded.

Note: Do not graze or feed treated cotton, safflower, or sunflower forage to livestock.

Rotational Crops

Land treated with Tolban 4E may be rotated to other crops in the fall or in the following spring.

Do not plant cotton, safflower, or sunflower in land treated with Tolban 4E. Do not plant cotton, safflower, or sunflower in land treated with Tolban 4E if the previous crop was a cereal grain, soybean, or a legume.

Danger:
