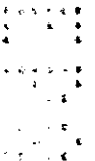

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Touchdown Home and Garden Concentrate is a nonselective foliar systemic herbicide used to control a broad spectrum of emerged grass and broadleaf weeds, both annual and perennial, **down to the roots**. Any product not absorbed by plants breaks down into natural materials without moving in or on the soil to untreated plants. Touchdown Home and Garden Concentrate may be used in the following areas:

- Along fences
- Around fruit trees, vegetables, shrubs, or trees
- Gardens



- Lawn replacement
- Patios, walkways, driveways, gravel or mulch beds
- Stumps

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage

Use and store this product in its original container. Store product in a secure storage area. Protect from freezing.

Container Disposal

Do not use container for any use other than as described on this label. Partially filled or empty container may be disposed of by wrapping in several layers of newspaper and discarding in trash. In case of a spill or leak, soak up with absorbent paper towels and discard in trash. Container is not safe for food, feed, or drinking water.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES

When and How to Apply

- Spray only the weeds or grasses you want to kill. Spray weeds or grasses until thoroughly wet.
- For best results, apply to actively growing weeds during warm, sunny weather when air temperature is above 60°F.
- Apply when air is calm to prevent drift to desirable plants.
- Apply when weeds are small and before seeds form. Established weeds may require retreatment.
- Sprayed weeds usually begin to wilt within hours after application with complete kill in 1-2 weeks.
- When spot spraying, use a cardboard or plastic shield to protect desirable plants from being sprayed. If desirable plants are accidentally sprayed, rinse them off immediately with ample water.
- Rainproof: rainfall or watering 2 hours after application will not reduce weed control.

- If used around caneberries, fruit trees, grapevines, or nut trees, wait 21 days before harvesting.

Vine Kill

- To kill vines growing up poles, or trunks with mature bark, cut vines to a height of 3-4 ft. and spray vines thoroughly.
- To kill vines climbing up shrubs, or tree trunks with green bark, cut vines at base and spray regrowth or stumps. Shield shrubs and green bark from spray drift with a sheet of cardboard or plastic.

Important Note:

- Do not spray plants or grasses you desire to keep. They may die too.
- Not recommended for spot weed control in lawns since lawn grasses will be killed.

Lawn Replacement

For lawn replacement, use Touchdown Home and Garden Concentrate to kill lawn and weeds before planting new lawn.

- Skip one mowing before spraying.
- Use 6 fl. ozs. (12 tablespoons) per gallon water for each 300 sq. ft.
- If soil is dry, water before application and again 2-3 days after application.
- If green patches remain after 7 days, reapply.
- Wait 7 days after last application to rake, till, or replant with seed or sod.

Stumps

- Cut living stumps as close to the ground as possible.
- Drive 3-5 holes into the freshly cut stump and pour undiluted product into each hole.

When to Replant

Planting After Application	For These Plants
Wait 1 Day	Ornamental flowers, trees and shrubs and the following berries, fruits, vegetables and herbs: Artichoke (Jerusalem), Beans (all), Beet Greens, Blackberry, Blueberry, Boysenberry, Broccoli, Brussels Sprouts, Cabbage (all), Carrot, Cauliflower, Celery, Chard (Swiss), Chicory, Collards, Cranberry, Currant, Dewberry, Elderberry, Endive, Gooseberry, Horseradish, Huckleberry, Kale, Kohlrabi, Leek, Lentils, Lettuce, Loganberry, Mustard Greens, Okra, Olallieberry, Onion, Parsley, Parsnips, Potato Radish, Rape Greens, Raspberry (black and red), Rhubarb, Rutabaga, Spinach, Sweet Potato, Turnip, Yams
Wait 3 Days	Cantaloupe, Corn, Cucumber, Eggplant, Garlic, Gourds, Groundcherry, Melons (all), Peas (all), Pepper (all), Pumpkin, Squash (all), Tomatillo, Tomatoes (by seed), Watercress, Watermelon
Wait 7 Days	Lawn Grasses
Wait 30 Days	Tomatoes from Transplant, Unlisted Fruits, Vegetables, Herbs

MIXING PROCEDURES

- Use a tank sprayer made of plastic, fiberglass, plastic lined steel, or stainless steel.
- Add 6 fl. ozs. (12 tablespoons) to 1 gal. of water for best results.
- Spot treat or spray uniformly over 300 sq. ft.
- For easy to kill weeds, such as seedling weeds, use 3 fl. ozs. (6 tablespoons) per gallon of water for each 300 sq. ft.

To clean sprayer, rinse sprayer and all parts with water three times. Spray rinse water on bare soil or gravel.
