# **HOW IT WORKS**

[Unique] [Three way-action:] Kills tops. Kills roots. Keeps weeds from coming back. One ingredient provides fast control on contact. - Twist nozzle tip to adjust the spray pattern.
- Spray according to directions See How to Apply.

# **Directions for [Easy Pump] Pressure Sprayer**

- 1. Cut [carefully] cut the two [black] zip ties which secure [both] the pump handle and sprayer applicator. [photo/illustration #1]
- 2. Assemble remove the [three] wand sections and [screw] [connect] together, hand tighten but do not over tighten the small "O" rings assure a proper seal. [photo/illustration #2]
- 3. Unwind hose and sprayer handle from container. [Attach] [screw] wand (step 2) [to] [onto] handle [photo/illustration #3].
- 4. Pump make sure pump handle is screwed on tightly or the bottle will not pressurize. [Note: New, full bottles may require less pumping than when bottle has been previously used.] Pump container 15 to 20 times to pressurize. [Pumping to the higher range will provide longer spraying time.] [After pressurizing,] push pump handle down and turn clockwise to lock into sprayer base. [Note this bottle has been designed to expand when pressurized and can not be over pressurized.] [When pressurized you should will be able to spray for up to 5 minutes without pressurizing again (depending on how full the bottle is).] [photo/illustration #4]
- 5. Spray aim wand at the desired weed or area to be treated. Firmly press trigger [on wand] to spray [insert brand name]. Spray pattern can be adjusted by rotating end nozzle of spray tip. Spray weeds/grasses [and the entire area you wish to control for weeds/grasses] thoroughly (until wet). [photo/illustration #5]
- 6. Store When you are finished spraying, snap the wand back into the handle [or other indentations on bottle] for storage. [photo/illustration #6]
- 7. Depressurize make sure handle is still securely locked into sprayer then turn the entire sprayer counter clockwise to relieve pressure. Retighten and store in a location securely out of reach of children and pets. [photo/illustration #7]

# Directions for EZ Pull and Apply™ Sprayer

- Remove sprayer and hose from side carrier.
- Insert [color] plug at end of hose into [color] spout on cap until it clicks into place.
- Flip up spout.
- Grasp sprayer by the handle and point away from body.

- Slowly pull the ring at the bottom of the spray handle.
- Twist nozzle tip to adjust the spray pattern.
- Press and hold button on the sprayer to begin spraying.
- Pull ring at bottom of sprayer as needed to continue spraying.
- Spray according to directions See How to Apply.

#### **HOW TO APPLY**

- Shake gently before using.
- Spray only the weeds you want to kill. Spray until thoroughly wet.
- To control established weeds, apply when weeds are actively growing.
- [Be sure to spray the entire area you wish to control weeds, not just the weeds you see.]
- [Apply [Glyphosate Diquat Prodiamine EW RTU] to both existing weeds and [ground beneath] [weed-prone areas] where weeds have not yet appeared.]
- [IMPORTANT: To [create a preemergent barrier and] prevent new weeds and grasses from appearing, [spray] [treat] the entire area you want to remain free of weeds, as well as the weeds already present.
- Apply when weeds are small and before seeds form. Established weeds may require re-treatment.
- Optimal results are generally obtained when the air temperature is above 60°F.
- Apply when air is calm to prevent drift to desirable plants.
- [Note: Application will result in a temporary yellow coloration of the area sprayed, which will allow you to see where you have treated.] [To hasten fading, rinse area with hose at least 24 hours after application.]

## [32 oz.]

To empty container add 1.25 oz. (2.5 Tbs.) of [Glyphosate Diquat Prodiamine EW Concentrate] then slowly fill with water [to avoid foaming].

#### [1/2 gal.]

To empty container add 2.5 oz. (5 Tbs.) of [Glyphosate Diquat Prodiamine EW Concentrate] then slowly fill with water [to avoid foaming].

#### [1 gal.]

To empty container add 5 oz. (10 Tbs.) of [Glyphosate Diquat Prodiamine EW Concentrate] then slowly fill with water [to avoid foaming].

## [1.33 gal.]

To empty container add 6.5 oz. (13 Tbs.) of [Glyphosate Diquat Prodiamine EW Concentrate] then slowly fill with water [to avoid foaming].

#### [1.6 gal]

To empty container add 8 oz. (1Cup) of [Glyphosate Diquat Prodiamine EW Concentrate] then slowly fill with water [to avoid foaming].
