FIRST AID TREATMENT

CALL A PHYSICIAN IMMEDIATELY.

SKIN:-Immediately remove all contaminated clothing including shoes, and wash with plenty of warm water and soap. Wash clothing and remove all traces of material from shoes before re-use.

EYES:-Immediately flush with water for at least 15 minutes.

ANTIDOTE:-Give a tablespoon of salt in a glass of water and repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Have patient lie down and keep warm and quiet.

FOR PHYSICIANS ONLY:-Therapeutic doses of ATROPINE appear to be helpful in the treatment of poisoning.
