**— DIRECTIONS —**

**INSECTS CONTROLLED:** Efficient control of aphids (green fly and black fly), most thrips, chrysanthemum and rose midge.

**PRECAUTIONS:** Do not fumigate tender plants. Never use on African Violets.

**WARNING:** Poisonous by swallowing, inhalation or skin contact! Do not breathe fumes. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. **— PROCEDURE —**

Close all doors, windows and ventilators tightly. Plug all holes, cracks or openings in glass. Do not fumigate greenhouse if foliage of plants is wet. Maintain temperature of greenhouse between 70° to 80° F. Place each fumigator in the greenhouse walk upon a tin, brick or overturned flower pot keeping fumigators at least 2 feet away from plants. Puncture both triangular marks as indicated on side of can using tool provided. If vertical evolution of smoke is preferred puncture can on top lid instead of sides. Insert ignited lighter. Where the greenhouse being fumigated requires that generators be placed in more than one walk it is recommended that one person be assigned to light the fumigators in each walk, starting at the end farthest from the exit, so that the fumigation in each walk may start simultaneously, and the persons exit from the house simultaneously. The fumigators will commence to smoke immediately and the dose will continue to be effective for several hours. It is recommended that the ventilators of the house be kept closed all night wherever possible to secure maximum killing effect of this application. On tender crops that are in flower, a good precaution is to ventilate the house after about 2 1/2 to 3 hours. Ventilate house thoroughly after fumigation before permitting work to be done there. Ventilate at least 2 hours. Re-fumigate as reinfestation appears.
