For the Bunch or Runner types make first application during the first ten days of July. On Spanish type, dusting should be started about ten days earlier following with two or three applications, at as nearly fourteen day intervals as weather conditions permit. Should an application be washed off within a few hours, the treatment should be repeated as soon as weather conditions will permit. Additional applications may be necessary if insects and disease conditions persist.


