**DIRECTIONS**

This material is intended for use as a dust on peanuts for the control of Cercospora leaf-spot. Applications should be made at the rate of 20 to 25 pounds per acre with a dusting machine capable of depositing a thin uniform coating of dust on all above ground plant surfaces. Begin applications when disease first appears in the area and repeat at 14 day intervals for a total of three to four applications.

**CAUTION**

Avoid breathing dust. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Harmful if swallowed.

Applications of dusting or spraying materials containing sulphur should not be made just prior to or during periods of excessively high temperatures.
