DIRECTIONS

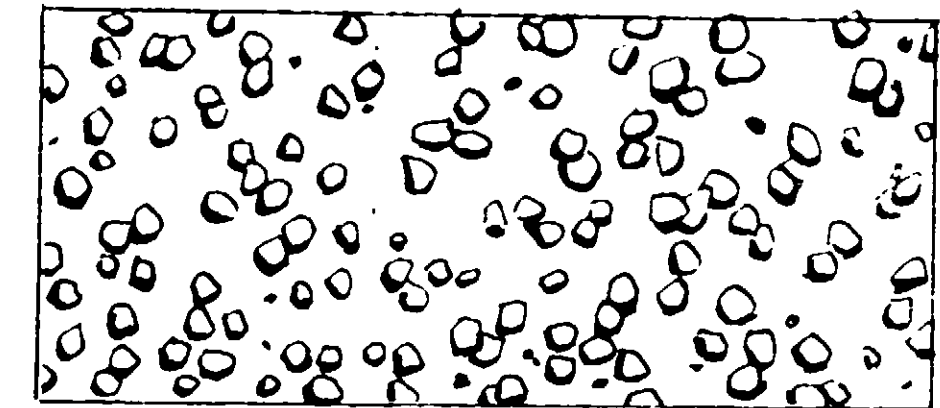
BEFORE APPLICATION

1. Remove existing weeds.
2. Thoroughly work and smooth area to be treated.
3. Carefully measure area to be treated and determine the number of square feet. If area is large, divide into smaller sections and treat sections individually.
4. Invert product container and mark the level of the CASORON GRANULES.

APPLICATION AND RATE

Shake CASORON GRANULES uniformly on soil at rate of 1 unit (0.75 ounce) for each 10 sq. ft. to be treated.

20 ounces treats 270 sq. ft. of area.



Rates higher than those indicated may cause plant injury.

More accurate and uniform application can be obtained by applying one-half of the required granules over the entire treatment area and repeating the application with the remaining granules.

CASORON GRANULES should not be used on sloping areas as run-off may result in injury to lawn or plants in adjacent areas.

AFTER APPLICATION

Unless soil is wet, sprinkle lightly to moisten soil to depth of 1/4 to 1/2 inch. DO NOT FLOOD. Avoid puddling and washing.

Avoid disturbing soil in treated areas as long as weed-control is being maintained.

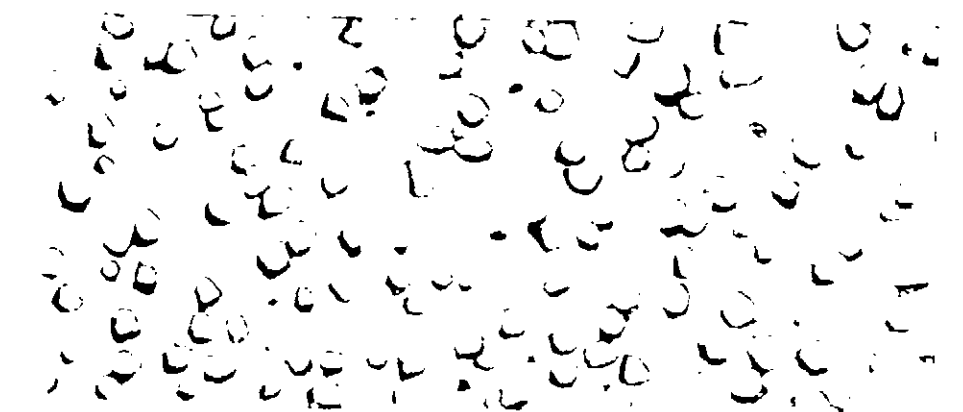
BEFORE APPLICATION

3. Measure area to be treated and determine the number of square feet to be treated. Divide into smaller sections and treat each section individually.
4. Invert product container and shake the top of the CASORON GRANULES.
