The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. Five copies of the finished labeling must be submitted at the next printing.

1. Expand the Directions for Use section by providing complete instructions on the application or use of the product.
2. Delete "or Wetlands" from the Environmental Hazards statements.
3. The Storage and Disposal section must be transferred to within or immediately following the Directions for Use.
4. Transfer the heading "Precautionary Statements, Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals" to the back panel. Delete "Warning" on the back panel. Transfer the front panel precautionary statement to the back panel, below the transferred headings.

These changes are necessary to bring the label up to current standards. For additional information, you may want to refer to the "Federal Register" publication, September 26, 1984, beginning on page 37960. This article details EPA pesticide labeling requirements.
