

DIRECTIONS

FOR CATTLE: To protect dairy animals from horn flies, stable flies, house flies, spray twice daily using 1 to 2 ounces per animal depending on the size of the animal. Cover the animal with spray with particular attention to back, flanks, and legs. Do not soak the skin or wet the hide. Such applications will kill stable flies, horn flies, and house flies present at the time of application on the animal and would afford several hours temporary protection from these flies.

FOR HORSES: Spray lightly or spongehorses, using 1 to 2 ounces per adult animal, proportionately less for smaller animals. Give special attention to shanks, legs and shoulders. Apply till hair is moistened, but do not soak hide. FOR PIGS: Spray lightly where flies congregate. Repeat as needed.

FOR BARNS, STABLES AND MILK ROOMS: When used as space spray, direct power sprayer toward upper portion of the enclosure until the area is filled with a fine mist. Doors and windows need not be closed during or after application. If coarse spray is used, apply directly on walls, stanchions, ceilings, window and door frames, wherever flies alight or congregate, until surfaces are moistened. Avoid direct contact with food or food utensils. Leavedoors and windows open during application to permit flies to leave. After fly population is reduced, doors and windows may be closed. Spray out door surfaces also to discourageflies from ing there. Repeat as needed.
