

DIRECTIONS FOR FAVEST

FOR CONTROL of stable flies, horn flies, face flies, horses, and hogs.

Mix 1 quart of Ciodrin Emulsible Concentrate per 4 gallons of water animal, including the legs, using 1/2 pint of spray per large animal, more often on smaller ones. Do not contaminate food, feed or drinking water.

For personal control operations in dousing spray applications to livestock. Mix 1 quart Ciodrin Emulsible Concentrate per 6 gallons legs, avoid excessive spraying to the head, using 1/2 quarts of spray.

Improved face fly control may be achieved by adding sugar to the spray. Repeat above application as necessary to maintain control, but not

LOW VOLUME application for control of face flies.

Mix 1 tablespoon of 100 cones of Ciodrin Emulsible Concentrate and sprayer apply 1/2 oz of spray to the face and a total of 10 ml.

Improved control may be achieved by the addition of 1 level tablespoon.

FOR CONTROL of house flies, face flies and stable flies in and around Concentrate per 4 gallons of water, 1% concentration spray prevents flies, Jones and other resting or breeding places at least twice a square foot. Do not contaminate food, feed or drinking water.

Improved house fly and face fly control may be achieved by adding gallons of spray.

FOR CONTROL of stable flies, horn flies, house flies, and face flies.

Mix 8 tablespoons of 100 cones of Ciodrin Emulsible Concentrate to cover all parts of the animal, including the legs, using 1/2 pint of power sprayer. Do not contaminate food, feed or drinking water.

Improved control may be achieved by the addition of 1 level tablespoon.

FOR CONTROL of face and winter ticks on dairy cattle, beef cattle, Concentrate per 4 gallons of water, 0.1-0.2% spray and take th

contaminate food, feed or drinking water.

BACK RUBB RAP

For use in back rubbers or tick numbers for the control of from the per 7 gallons of back rubber base oil, 1% concentration. This may accordance with recommendations of your State Extension Service.



GENERAL DIRECTIONS

Codrin Emulsible Concentrate is suitable for use in conventional hydraulic sprayers or low pressure knapsack sprayers.

DIRECTIONS FOR LIVESTOCK PEST CONTROL

FOR CONTROL of stable flies, horn flies, face flies, house flies and stable ticks on dairy cattle, sheep, goats and hogs.

Mix 1 quart of Codrin Emulsible Concentrate per 4 gallons of water (1/4 concentration). Spray to thoroughly cover all parts of the animal, including the legs, using 1/2 pints of spray per large animal and proportionately less for smaller animals. Do not apply more often than 7 days. Do not contaminate food, feed or drinking water.

For power spray operations involving spray applications to livestock with high pressure equipment, do not exceed this concentration. Mix 1 quart Codrin Emulsible Concentrate per 4 gallons of water. Spray to thoroughly cover the animal's body and legs, avoid excessive spraying to the head, using 1/2 quarts of spray per large animal and proportionately less for smaller animals.

Improved face fly control may be achieved by adding sugar to the spray solution at the rate of 1 pound per 6-10 gallons of spray. Repeat above application as necessary to maintain control, but not more often than once every 7 days.

LOW VOLUME application for control of face flies.

Mix 1 tablespoon - 2 fluid ounces of Codrin Emulsible Concentrate per 1/2 pint of water (1/2 concentration). Using a garden end sprayer, apply 1/2 pint of spray to the face and a total of 10 ml. to the back and sides of the animal 3 times per week.

Improved control may be achieved by the addition of 1 level tablespoon of sugar per pint of spray solution.

FOR CONTROL of house flies, face flies and stable flies in and around Livestock buildings. Mix 1 quart of Codrin Emulsible Concentrate per 4 gallons of water (1/4 concentration). Spray ~~front~~ ~~back~~ ~~sides~~ ~~around~~ ~~barn~~ walls, including dairy barns, caves, fences and other resting or breeding places at least twice a month using approximately 1 gallon of finished spray per 1000 square feet. Do not contaminate food, feed or drinking water.

Improved house fly and face fly control may be achieved by adding sugar to the spray solution at the rate of 1 pound per 6-10 gallons of spray.

FOR CONTROL of stable flies, horn flies, house flies and face flies on dairy and beef cattle.

Mix 8 tablespoons - 1/3 fluid ounces of Codrin Emulsible Concentrate per 1/2 pint of water (1/2 concentration). Spray to thoroughly cover all parts of the animal, including the legs, using 1/2 fluid ounces of spray per animal. Apply daily with conventional tank or power sprayers. Do not contaminate food, feed or drinking water.

Improved control may be achieved by the addition of 1 level tablespoon of sugar per pint of spray solution.

FOR CONTROL of face and winter ticks on dairy cattle, beef cattle, sheep, goats and hogs. Mix 1/2 pint of Codrin Emulsible Concentrate per 4 gallons of water (0.125% spray) and spray animals thoroughly using up to 1/2 gallons of spray per animal. Cover entire and up to 1 gallon of spray for the 0.25% concentration. Repeat application is necessary to maintain control. Do not contaminate food, feed or drinking water.

BACK RUBBER APPLICATIONS

For use in back rubbers or face rubbers for the control of house flies, face flies mix 1/2 pint of Codrin Emulsible Concentrate per 4 gallons of back rubber base oil (1/2 concentration). This may be done in oil or combinations of these fact and manner in accordance with recommendations of your State Extension Service.

PRECAUTIONS IN USING

Do not contaminate food, food or drinking water. During commercial or prolonged exposure to spray, gloves and/or respirator wear clean synthetic rubber gloves and a mask or respirator of a type found suitable by the U. S. Dept. of Agriculture for protection against Codrin insecticide. Use this material only for recommended purposes and do not eat or drink.

WARNING - HAZARDOUS IF SWALLOWED, INHALED OR ABSORBED THROUGH SKIN

Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating and smoking. Wear clean clothing. If contact occurs on person or clothing immediately remove clothing and flush skin with plenty of water. Get medical attention. Keep away from heat and open flame.
