The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with the registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act is acceptable subject to the comments listed below.

a) Revise the "If Swallowed" statement to read:

**IF SWALLOWED:**

- o Immediately call a poison control center or doctor.
- o Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor.
- o Do not give liquid to the person.
- o Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

b) Add the statement: **Note to Physician: Contains Petroleum distillate-vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.**

c) Revise the Environmental Hazards statement to read:

Do not apply directly to water. Add: This **pesticide is Toxic to fish.**

d) Revise the **Storage and Disposal** Statement to read:

Do not Puncture or Incinerate!

**If empty:** Place in trash or offer for recycling if available.

**If partly filled:** Call your local solid waste agency or **1-800-CLEANUP** which is managed as a public-private partnership.



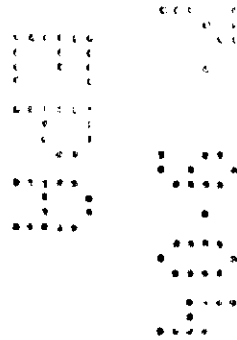

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Do not breathe vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin or eyes. Wash with soap and warm water after use.

Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

**FIRST AID STATEMENT**

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

- IF SWALLOWED:** Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
- IF IN EYES:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15 to 20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
- IF INHALED:** Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.

**ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**

Do not apply directly to water. *This product is toxic to fish.*

**PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS**

Contents under pressure. Keep away from heat, sparks, and open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting. Do not spray on plastic or asphalt tile.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **READ ENTIRE LABEL BEFORE USING THIS PRODUCT. USE STRICTLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH LABEL PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS AND DIRECTIONS.**

Shake well before using. Remove protective cap. Hold upright. Point spray opening away from you and press valve downward. Apply spray in short bursts.

**FOR HOUSEHOLD INSECTS**

**To Kill Flies, Flying Moths, Gnats, Hornets, Mosquitoes, Sandflies, Wasps and other Flying Insects:** Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a low, sweeping motion. Spray 5 to 10 seconds for average room (1,000 cu. ft.). Keep nozzle three feet from surfaces. Vacate premises. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects.

**To Kill Ants, Centipedes, Cockroaches, Crickets, Firebrats, Scorpions, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders and Waterbugs:** Spray baseboards, cracks, crevices, moist areas and openings around sinks and pipes and other hiding places, hitting the insects directly. Spray ant hills and ant trails around windows and door sills and other locations. Repeat as necessary.

**To Kill Clothes Moths:** Spray all articles to be protected, giving particular attention to folds and seams. Spray interior of storage container such as closets, chests and trunks regularly. Treatment should be repeated every thirty days unless the articles are stored in moth-tight containers.

**To Kill Bedbugs:** Spray mattresses thoroughly, especially around seams and tufts. Spray bedstead, baseboards and floorboards. Repeat as needed.

**To Kill Carpet Beetles:** Directly spray as many insects as possible. Spray both interior and exterior of upholstered furniture. Both top and bottom of rugs and carpets should be sprayed thoroughly. Also treat shelves, closets, areas under furniture and wherever these insects are seen or suspected. Repeat as necessary.

**To Kill Exposed Forms of Confused Flour Beetles, Rice Weevils and Saw-toothed Grain Beetles:** Find and destroy infested package goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

**To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas:** Remove and destroy pet's old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray animals. Put fresh bedding in pet's quarters after the spray has dried. Also treat dogs and cats with a registered flea and tick control product before allowing them to enter treated area.

To treat carpets, spray at the rate of one square foot per second. Repeat as necessary.

**To Kill Aphids (plant lice), Spider Mites, Exposed Thrips, Lace Bugs and certain other insects on house plants:** Spray in short bursts, holding can 18 inches from foliage for such plants as English Ivy and African Violet. Spray both sides of the leaves lightly. Do not wet. Repeat as often as necessary.

#### FOR GARDEN PESTS

**To Kill sucking insects such as aphids, leafhoppers, spotted mites, thrips (exposed) lace bug, and chewing insects such as climbing cutworms and Japanese beetles:** On such plants as Asters, Azaleas, Begonias, Chrysanthemums, Dahlias, Delphiniums, Gladioli, Irises, Marigolds, Petunias, Roses and Snap-dragons. Also for bugs on evergreen and small ornamental deciduous trees, shrubs and vines.

For best results spray in evening or on a cloudy day when air is still. Use slow sweeping motion. Keep can 18 inches from plants. Avoid wetting foliage with the spray. Spray rows at the rate of 1 ft. per second. For heavy growth, spray row on both sides. Repeat when needed. Spray with caution on young plants and new growth. Do not spray garden when temperature exceeds 90°F.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

**STORAGE:** To be stored in original container and placed in an area inaccessible to children. Do not store near heat or open flame.

**DISPOSAL:** If empty - Do not puncture or incinerate this container. Do not place in trash compactor. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. If partly filled - If product cannot be used as directed, or offered to others for their use, call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-CLEANUP for disposal instructions. Never spray unused product down any indoor (including toilet) or outdoor (including sewer) drain.
