On the basis of information furnished by the registrant, the above named pesticide is hereby registered/reregistered under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act.

2. Rewrite your **Precautionary Statement** update the language to read as follows:

Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes or clothing. [Wear protective eyewear.] Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco or using the toilet. Wear long-sleeved shirts, long pants, socks, shoes and chemical resistant gloves.

- 3. Reverse the order of the First Aid Statement to match the order of the Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals Statement: If in eyes followed by If on skin or clothing.
- 4. On page 2 make the following changes using more definitive language as required by the Agency.
  - Remove "General" from the heading "General Information." An example of more definitive language would be: "Information Specific to this Product" or any other definitive language of your choosing.
  - Under the heading Application to Ornamentals" in the second sentence of the paragraph delete the word "should" and replace it with more definitive wording; for example: using the word "must" or rewrite the sentence, as "Make application prior to anticipated pest infestation to maximize control."...
- 4. On page 3 remove the word **Recommended** from the heading **Recommended Applications**. More definitive wording would be: "**Applications Use for Listed Pests**".

Also on page 3 delete the word "Recommended" seconded heading leaving the remainder of the heading "Applications for use on Ornamentals"

- 5. On page 5 under heading **Restrictions** remove or change the word "should" in the last sentence to the word "must" or chose other definitive language such as **observe a 12-month** plant back interval or a 12 month plant back interval much be observed."
- 6. You must generate studies for the guidelines 830.6314 (oxidation-reduction), 830.6315 (flammability), 830.6316 (explodability), and a one year Storage Stability study (830.6317) and Corrosion Characteristics study (830.6320) and submit them to the Agency. The Agency recommends that observations be made at 0, 3, 6, 9, and 12 months for guidelines 830.6317 and 830.6320.

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7. Submit two copies of your final printed label before you release the product for shipment. If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitute acceptance of these conditions.

#### **ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS**

This product is highly toxic to aquatic invertebrates. Do not apply directly to water, or to areas where surface water is present or to intertidal areas below the mean high water mark. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters.

#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

This product can be used for the control of soil inhabiting pests of turfgrass, such as Northern & Southern masked chafers, Cyclocephala borealis, C. immaculata, and/or C. lurida; Asiatic garden beetle, Maladera castanea; European chafer, Rhizotroqus majalis; Green June Beetle, Cotinis nitida; May or June beetles, Phyllophaga spp.; Japanese beetle, Popillia japonica; Oriental beetle, Anomala orientalis; Billbugs, Spherophorus spp.; Annual bluegrass weevil, Hyperodes spp.; Black turfgrass ataenius, Ataenius spretulus; Aphodius spp.; European Crane Fly, Tipula paludosa; and Mole crickets, Scapteriscus spp. This product can also be used for the suppression of cutworms and chinchbugs in turfgrass areas. This product can be used as directed on turfgrass in sites such as home lawns, business and office complexes, shopping complexes, multi-family residential complexes, golf courses, airports, cemeteries, parks, playgrounds, and athletic fields. This product cannot be used on commercial sod farms.

The active ingredient in this product has sufficient residual activity so that applications can be made preceding the egg laying activity of the target pests. High levels of control can be achieved when applications are made preceding or during the egg laying period. The need for an application can be based on historical monitoring of the site, previous records or experiences, current season adult trapping or other methods. Optimum control will be achieved when applications are made prior to egg hatch of the target pest, followed by sufficient irrigation or rainfall to move the active ingredient through the thatch. Do not apply when turf is water saturated. The treated area must be in such a condition that rainfall or irrigation will penetrate vertically into the soil profile. Applications cannot exceed a total of 8 pounds (0.4 lb. of active ingredient) per acre per year.

#### **APPLICATION TO ORNAMENTALS**

This product can be used as a broadcast application on ornamentals in commercial and residential landscapes, as well as on landscaped areas of golf courses and other recreational areas. Application should be made prior to anticipated pest infestation to maximize control. Rainfall, irrigation and mechanical incorporation after application will also aid in maximizing control.

Applications of this product cannot exceed a total of 8 pounds (0.4 lb. of active ingredient) per acre per year.

**NOTE:** Not for use in commercial greenhouses, nurseries, on sod farms or on grass grown for seed. For use on plants intended for aesthetic purposes or climatic modification and being grown in interior plantscapes, ornamental gardens or parks, or on golf courses or lawns and grounds.

#### APPLICATION EQUIPMENT

Apply this product uniformly over the area being treated with typical granular application equipment. Both drop-type and retery-type spreaders may be used to apply this product. Avoid the use of spreaders which would apply the material in nurrow, concentrated bands. It is recommended that all spreader equipment be calibrated at the time of application to achieve desired application rate.

NOTE: For optimum control, irrigation or rainfall should occur within 24 hours after application to move the active ingredient through the thatch. On golf courses, irrigate treated areas following application. Do not apply more than 8 pounds (0.4 lb. of active ingredient) per acre per year. Avoid mowing turf or lawn area until after irrigation or rainfall has occurred so that uniformity of application will not be affected.

#### RESTRICTIONS

Avoid runoff or puddling of irrigation water following application. Avoid application of this product to areas which are waterlogged or saturated, which will not allow penetration into the root zone of the plant. Do not apply more than 8 pounds (0.4 lb. of active ingredient) per acre per year.

Treated areas may be replanted with any crop specified on an imidacloprid label, or with any crop for which a tolerance exists for the active ingredient.

For crops not listed on an imidacloprid label, or for crops for which no tolerances for the active ingredient have been established, a 12-month plant-back interval should be observed.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.
