The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section 3(c)(7)(A) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided that you:

1. Submit/cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:
  - a. Refer to eggs as Food Grade prior to Directions for Use heading. Also in first sentence ". . . to sanitize and wash eggs . . ." rather than clean eggs.
  - b. Change the ounces of CDB Clearon Wash and Surface Sanitizer so you will only have 100 ppm available chlorine maximum for sanitizing solution as stated in 21 CFR 178.1010 for triazinetriones.
  - c. Add to the label an instruction that the purchaser must be able to check chlorine level with an appropriate Chlorine Test Kit. Cannot fall below 50 ppm and not above 100 ppm. Add under Directions for Use heading; see enclosed sample label.


