DIRECTIONS

BROCCOLI, CAULIFLOWER, CABBAGE, BRUSSELS SPROUTS: Cabbage Caterpillars, Cabbage Looper—1¼ qts. per acre in water to cover. Do not apply to Broccoli, Cauliflower and Brussels Sprouts after the edible parts start to form or within 30 days of harvest. Do not apply to cabbage after heads start to form.

GRASSHOPPERS AND CRICKETS on Corn, Lettuce, Sorghum, Soybeans and Tomatoes—Use 2½ to 3 pints of ORTHO Toxaphene 4.8 Emulsive per acre as a spray in sufficient water for even distribution. Treat roadsides, field margins, idle land and the fields themselves when main hatch is completed or when young hoppers begin to move. Treat margins of cornfields and adjacent land. Late in the season, when most of the grasshoppers are adults and vegetation is tall and dense, a slight increase in the dosage of both sprays and dust may be necessary. Do not feed treated Soybeans or Corn forage to dairy animals or animals being finished for slaughter. Do not apply to Sorghum within 28 days of har-

vest. Do not apply to Sorghum more than once after heads start to form. Do not graze dairy animals or animals being finished for slaughter in treated Sorghum fields and do not ensile treated forage. Do not apply after seedling stage for leaf lettuce. Do not apply on head lettuce after heads start to form. Do not apply to Tomatoes within 1 day of harvest. Do not apply to soybeans within 21 days of harvest. Do not feed treated soybean plants or ensilage made from treated plants to poultry, dairy animals or animals being finished for slaughter. Do not feed soybean mill trash to livestock or poultry.

ANTS—For control of common house-infesting Ants, including the Argentine Ant, and Pharaoh's Ant or the Little Red Ant: Use 5 gallons in 95 gallons of water to make 100 gallons of spray. Treat outside of buildings at ground level; along porches, walks, out-buildings; and near known ant nest and runways. Repeat at monthly intervals or as necessary.

FLIES—For Houseflies: Use 5 gallons in 95 gallons of water to make 100 gallons of spray. Spray the outside of buildings, including porches, and apply as a light mist spray without causing excessive run-off. Repeat monthly or as necessary.
