... under 3 months of age. Do not spray or dip animals when weather is stormy or heavy rain may be expected. Do not spray or dip over heated animals. **DO NOT USE ON DAIRY ANIMALS** IN BARRIS, MILK ROOMS, MILK PROCESSING ROOMS OR POULTRY HOUSES. Do not spray, treat cattle, sheep, or goats within 30 days of slaughter. Do not dip livestock within 60 days of slaughter. Do not treat sows or pigs of farrowing nor for at least 3 weeks thereafter.

**AVOID** Agitate spray thoroughly and keep agitated during spraying.

**CATTLE** **HORSES** **MULES**—Lice, Ticks, Horn Flies, Stable Flies. Use Dilution Table No. 4. Spray the animal thoroughly. Do not overspray. Use about 2 quarts of diluted spray per adult animal. Each spray will afford protection for 2 weeks. Repeat as necessary. For tick one treatment will usually be sufficient for a season using Dilution Table No. 4. For longer protection against above listed pests—Use Dilution Table No. 3.

**PIGS** **SUPPLEMENTAL CONTROL**—Treat animals as above. **PRIMARY CONTROL**—Use Dilution Table No. 3 applying to hogs, piglets and other areas of barns and other outbuildings. **DO NOT USE DILUTION TABLE NO. 3 ON PIGS.**

Use Dilution Table No. 2. Spray animal thoroughly. One treatment usually is sufficient for a season.

**GOATS**—Lice and Sheep Keds (ticks). Use Dilution Table No. 2. Spray animal thoroughly using 1 quart to penetrate fleece. Ticks. Use Dilution Table No. 1. Spray thoroughly as above. **SCABIES ON SHEEP**—Use Dilution Table No. 4. Spray thoroughly as above. Repeat after 2 or 3 weeks if as needed.

**FOR CONTROL OF LISTED PESTS**—Use 1 gal. ORTHO Klean Stock Spray or Dip for 100 gal. water (Dilution Table No. 4). If water first with water then add required amount of ORTHO Klean Stock Spray or Dip. Stir thoroughly. Dip or longer. Any time dipping is stopped longer than 30 minutes, agitate thoroughly, before resuming. Completely submerge animals' body, once or twice. Dunk head at least twice. Do not use on calves or other animals under 3 months old, nor on dogs, cats or other household pets or poultry. If young animals between 3 and 6 months of age, use spray only. Always water animals before dipping so that they will not drink the dipping solution. Prolonged standing or excessive fith contamination in dipping vats, the active chemical agents may separate. Do not use such separated dipping solution, since death to animals may occur. Clean vat and use fresh solution.

**FEEDBACK RUBBERS** for Range Cattle to control Horn Flies—1.1 ORTHO Klean Stock Spray or Dip for 1 gal. water. **DO NOT USE ON DAIRY ANIMALS.** Do not treat beef cattle within 30 days of slaughter.

**SPRAY—FLIES** **DO NOT USE THIS DOSAGE ON ANIMALS.** Use Dilution Table No. 3. Spray thoroughly on hog pens, calf pens, stables, garbage cans and similar places.

 Keep pesticide in original container. Do not dilute concentrate or dilute into food or drink containers. Do not store in plastic or metal feed or food containers.

**PESTICIDE DISPOSAL**  
 Pesticide spray or dip concentrate cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to Federal, State or local procedures under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.

**CONTAINER DISPOSAL**  
 Triple-rinse, recycle, or dispose of in a voluntary, approved, or other approved State or local procedure.
