ORTHO Rotenone Dust or Spray contains Rotenone and other Associated Resins. It is for use in the control of certain garden pests on vegetables. Rotenone is a naturally occurring insecticide derived from certain plants found in Central and South America.

DIRECTIONS

Do not use on vegetables within 1 day of harvest.

AS A DUST: Dust thoroughly at rate of 1 lb. per 1,000 sq. ft. (30 to 40 lbs. per acre). Start application as soon as insects appear and repeat at 5 to 10 day intervals — unless otherwise specified.

AS A SPRAY: Mix 6 to 8 Tablespoonfuls in a little water to make a thin paste, add to 1 gallon water and agitate during application. Make new dilution for each use.

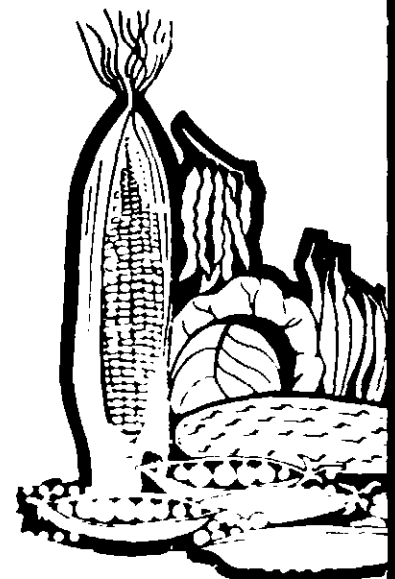
