ORNAMENTALS AND NURSERY STOCK: Two-Spotted Mite, Soft Brown Scale, Aphids—30 to 40 pounds per acre. Do not use on Boston, Maidenhair and Pteris ferns, and some species of Crassula.

PEACHES: Mites, Brown Rot—Use 50 lbs. per acre by air. Do not apply within 7 days of harvest. Do not use sulfur on peach foliage within 30 days of an oil spray application.

PRUNES: Leafhoppers, Mealy Plum Aphid, Brown Rot, Red Spider Mites, Bud Moth, Orange Tortrix, Brown Almond Mites—40 to 50 lbs. per acre. Apply from bud break to jacket stage. Avoid application during fall.

TOMATOES: Russet Mite, Two-Spotted Spider Mite—10 to 20 lbs. per acre. Do not apply within 10 days of harvest. Do not use sulfur on tomato foliage within 30 days of an oil spray application.
