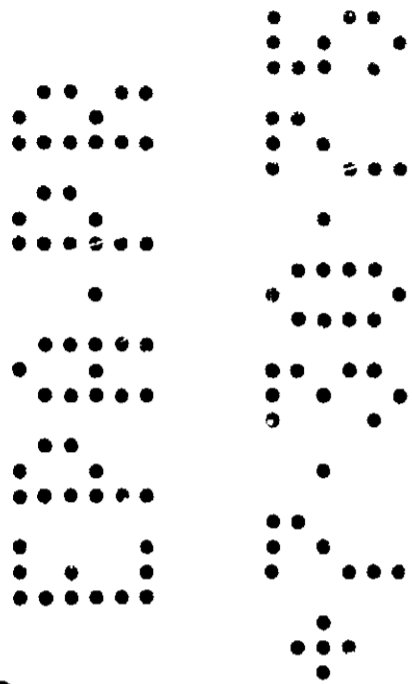

## ORTHO Indoor Plant Insect Spray

**READ ENTIRE LABEL. USE STRICTLY IN ACCORDANCE WITH LABEL CAUTIONS, WARNINGS AND DIRECTIONS.**  
**TO OPERATE:** Remove cap. Hold container in upright position about 18 to 24 inches from objects being sprayed. Press nozzle directed at insects or plants to be sprayed. Apply as a light spray, do not wet plants to a visible deposit.

**AFRICAN VIOLET, IVY, BRACKEN AND BOSTON FERN, FUCHSIA, PHILODENDRON, RUBBER PLANT, GLOXINIA: Aphids, Red Spider Mites, exposed Thrips**—Repeat application as necessary. **Whitefly, Mexican Mealybugs**—Use frequent repeated applications. On Mealybugs, apply as above, using special care to thoroughly wet insects. Put plants in suitable place for spraying. Spray from all sides including under and upper leaf surfaces. Hold container 18 to 24 inches from foliage. Use short one-second bursts. Avoid over wetting plants. Do not spray plants in hot sun, excessive heat or when excessively wet. Do not spray Maidenhair Fern, Lantana, Cyclamen, Roses or Poinsettias as injury may occur.
