#### DIRECTIONS

SHAKE BEFORE USING. Point valve opening away from face and push button, holding container as upright as possible.

#### HOUSEHOLD PESTS

**SPACE SPRAY** to control **FLYING INSECTS** (Flies, Gnats, Mosquitoes, Miller Moths)—Shut doors and windows, press valve filling room with mist, and direct spray to all parts of room, particularly the upper portions. Keep about 3 feet from walls, fabric, furniture. Keep room closed for at least 15 minutes. Air rooms before occupancy.

**CRAWLING INSECTS** (Ants, Roaches, Fleas, Box Elder Bugs, Spiders, Black Widow Spiders, Earwigs, Silverfish)—Direct spray on insects wherever possible. Also spray their trails, nests and other areas where they might be found such as under sinks, in cupboards, around baseboards, garbage cans, doors, windows, floors, floor coverings and pet sleeping quarters.

#### GARDEN PESTS

**ROSES, AFRICAN VIOLETS, AZALEAS, EVERGREENS AND CERTAIN OTHER SIMILAR FLOWERS AND ORNAMENTALS**—To control insects such as Aphids, Leafhopper, Diabrotica Beetle, Certain Caterpillars, Exposed Thrips, Adult White Fly: Important—Hold container 18 inches to 2 feet from foliage. Spray with a sweeping motion in one-second bursts. Direct spray on insects. Spray from all sides, covering foliage lightly. Avoid heavy wetting. Use caution on tender foliage, young plants and new growth. Do not apply in direct sunlight or to wet plants. Repeat as necessary. **White Fly Larvae, Mealybugs:** Use frequently and wet thoroughly. **Box Elder Bugs:** Spray directly on insects wherever found on plants. Do not spray plants in hot sun, excessive heat or when excessively wet. Do not spray Maidenhair Fern, Lantana or Cyclamen. Avoid spraying dull-leaved roses, as purpling of leaves may result. For more extensive spraying of your flower garden, it is recommended that you use ISOTOX Insect Spray applied with an ORTHO SPRAY-ETTE.

#### ANIMAL PESTS

**DOGS, CATS:** Fleas, Lice—Apply directly to animals along back, under forelegs and other infested areas. Part hair to contact skin. Hold nozzle about 1 foot away. Do not spray in eyes or mouth of animal.

**CAUTION:** Keep out of reach of children. Do not contaminate food, utensils, dishes or drinking water. Do not spray on plastics, asphalt tile or furniture.

**WARNING:** Contents under pressure. Do not puncture. Exposure to high temperatures may cause bursting. Keep at room temperature—away from direct sunlight, radiators, stoves, hot water and other heat. Never throw container into fire or incinerator.
