Refer to Federal Housing Administration, State and Local specifications for safe distances from water tanks, wells, Soil in the vicinity of wells, cisterns or ponds should be treated if new termite infestation is detected or if there is accumulation of water or if the soil to be treated around the perimeter of the structure is above ground level during yard or property area. If this is the situation, treat as follows: Do Not Apply Under Pressure. Use a fine spray to areas safe from well or domestic water. Concentration treated should not exceed one quart per cubic yard of soil. Return to the trench which has been lined with 4 mil plastic sheeting. Bury the cuttings in the trench securely when returning soil to the trench. Do not treat structures that contain stems of wells.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store pesticide in original container. Do not put concentrate or dilute into food or drink containers. Do not mix with other sprays. Make new dilution for each use. Do not reuse empty container. Write on label: DANGER - PESTICIDE.

STATEMENTS AND DIRECTIONS

For use on foundations of poured concrete and on foundations of poured concrete that extend down into the trench by digging below the bottom of the footing by the rate of 4 inches per 10' clear of the outside of foundations of concrete space.
