DIRECTIONS

SLURRY TREATMENT: When used in slurry treaters, do not allow mixtures to stand overnight. Clean out equipment thoroughly between treating operations.

GRASS SEED (Range Grasses such as Wheatgrass and Bromegrass): To control *Podosporella verticillata*: 12 ozs. ORTHOCLIDE Malathion 75-1 Seed Protectant per 100 lbs. seed. Apply as slurry treatment.

CAUTION: Avoid inhalation of dust. Wear a respirator. Avoid prolonged or repeated contact with skin. Wash thoroughly after using. Do not store or transport with feed or food.
