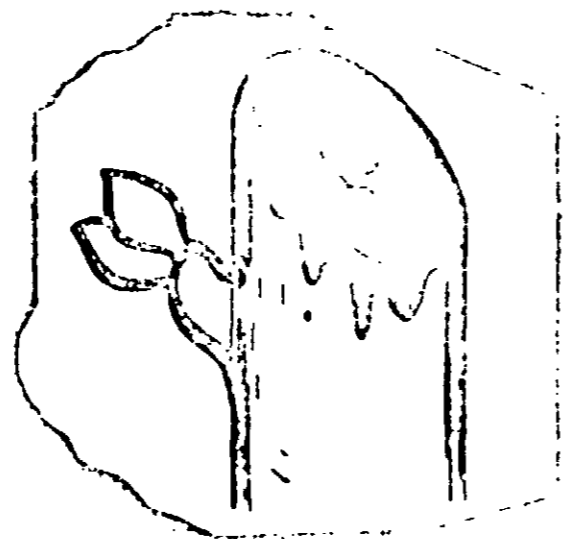

DIRECTIONS

TO OPERATE: Shake well. Remove cap. Hold container in upright position with nozzle pointed toward and 8 to 10 inches away from area to be sprayed. Push button to spray.

ROSES AND ORNAMENTALS: Treat all pruning cuts over 1/2 inch in diameter.

FRUIT AND SHADE TREES: Treat all pruning cuts over one inch in diameter. Cut decayed or dead limbs to sound wood and treat.

WOUNDS & ABRASIONS: Trim as required and treat.

WATERPROOFING PLANTING TUBS, ETC.: To seal small cracks and holes, make two applications, allowing first application to set overnight.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Spray away from fences, buildings, sidewalks, etc., to prevent staining. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not apply to humans, pets or birds.

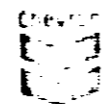

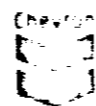
