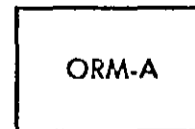

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, (FIFRA) is acceptable provided that you make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

1. The label should be updated to be in compliance with 40 CFR §162.10. Appropriate headings, subheadings, reformatting and addition of a Storage and Disposal section per PR Notice 83-3 and 84-1 are needed.
2. A Statement of Practical Treatment must be added to the labeling. We suggest the following statement, however, if your toxicological data suggests otherwise, please submit a draft Statement of Practical Treatment for prior approval:

If swallowed - Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of throat with a finger. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.

If inhaled - Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

If on skin - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

If in eyes - Flush eyes with plenty of water. Call a physician immediately.

Submit five (5) copies of your revised final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment with the amended labeling.

If you hold a Federal registration, a supplemental registration, or a Special Local Needs registration, you may continue to produce new stocks of such products, using current labeling, until April 1, 1984. After that date, all remaining inventories of affected products will fall under the Existing Stocks provisions stated in our letter of October 28, 1983.
