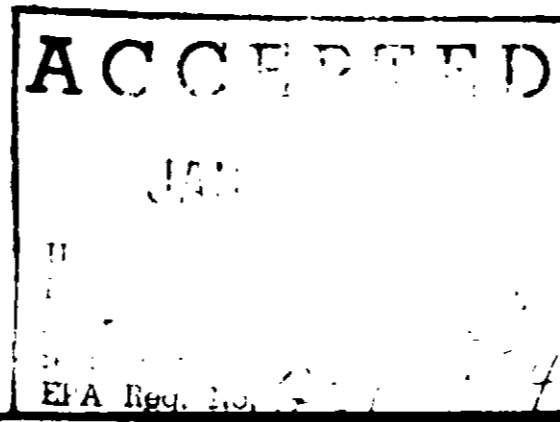

DIRECTIONS

Slurry Treatment – Apply at the rate of 1 oz. per bushel. For 46 cc cup, using dump weight of 10 lbs. add 1 lb. ORTHO Wheat Seed Protectant to 1 gal. water. For 23 cc cup, using dump weight of 10 lbs., add 2 lbs. ORTHO Wheat Seed Protectant to 1

gal. water. For "mist type" select a #15 cup, set dump weight for 6.8 lbs. and add 2 lbs. ORTHO Wheat Seed Protectant for every gal. of water in mixing tank. One gal. of slurry will treat approximately 1650 lbs. of seed.

Dust Treatment – Apply at the rate of 1 oz. per bushel. For best results, apply to the seed in any container or machine which will insure even coating of the powder over the seed.

READ THE LABEL
