HEAD LETTUCE: Green Peach Aphid, Aphids, Loopers, Imported Cabbage Worm, Diamond-Back Moth Larvae, Armyworms—20 to 25 lbs. per acre. Do not make more than 3 applications after thinning. Do not apply within 14 days of harvest. Remove outside leaves at harvest. Do not feed crop waste to livestock.

PEPPERS: Green Peach Aphid, Hornworms, Pepper Maggot—25 lbs. per acre. Do not apply within 1 day of harvest.

TOMATOES: Blister Beetles, Colorado Potato Beetles, Flea Beetles, Green Peach Aphid, Whitefly 12 lbs. per acre. Stink Bugs, Tomato Hornworms—15 to 25 lbs. per acre. Tomato Fruitworms, Yellow-Striped Armyworm 25 lbs. per acre. Apply when insects first appear and repeat as required. Dust plants thoroughly, particularly the under side of the leaves. Do not apply within 1 day of harvest.
