GENERAL DIRECTIONS

Ortho Yard & Patio Insect Spray is a fast-acting, non-oil insecticide that controls a wide variety of pests outside and inside the home. Refer to the table below for detailed directions. Repeat applications as necessary.

Mix 4 teaspoonsfuls ORTHO Yard & Patio Insect Spray in gallon water, unless otherwise specified. For best results use an ORTHO SPRAY ETTE Garden Hose Sprayer.

USES	INSECTS	COMMENTS
Patios, Yards and Other Outdoor Living Areas	Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Brown Dog Ticks, Roaches, Clover Mites, Ants	Spray patio, house foundations, under porches, lawn, along fences and shrubbery areas about 1 hour before cookout. AVOID SPRAYING ROSES, SPIREA, CHERRIES, as some injury may occur.
Household Insects	Roaches, House Flies, Fruit Flies, Brown Dog Ticks	8 Tablespoonfuls per gal water. Apply as a coarse spray or with a paint brush to window sills, baseboards, under sinks, stove and refrigerator and other areas frequented by pests. Avoid contamination of food dishes, utensils and water.
Lawn	Lawn Moth Larvae, Sod Webworms, Armyworms, Leafhoppers, Clover Mites, Thrips, Ants, Brown Dog Ticks	One cup - 8 fl. ozs. in 15 gals. water to treat 1,000 sq. ft. of lawn. Mow lawn and water well 1 to 2 days before treatment. Treat lawn in afternoon or early evening. Do not water lawn for 2 to 3 days following treatment.



GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Repeat applications as necessary. Mix 4 teaspoonsfuls ORTHO Yard & Patio Insect Spray in 1 gallon of water. Use this mixture at the rates specified. For best results use an ORTHO SPRAY ETC! Garden Hose Sprayer.

Patios, Yards, and Other Outdoor Living Areas	Fires, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Brown Dog Ticks, Roaches, Clover Mites, Ants	Spray patio, house, fence, lawns, under porches, lawn along fences and shrubbery areas about 1 foot from ground level. AVOID SPRAYING ROSES, SWEET ALMOND, CHERRY, PLUM, APRICOT, PEACH, NECTARINE, and other fruit trees. As some fruits may be damaged by spray.
Household Insects	Roaches, House Flies, Fruit Flies, Brown Dog Ticks	8 Tablespoonsfuls per gallon water. Apply with a coarse spray gun with a stiff brush to window sills, baseboards under sinks, stove and refrigerator and other areas as required by pests. Avoid spraying areas near or on foot. Wash clothes after use. When container is empty, immediately wash thoroughly and桑dry. Never reuse.
Lawns	Lawn Moth, Larvae, Sod Webworms, Armyworms, Cutworms, Thrips, Ants, Brown Dog Ticks	One cup 8 fluid oz. to 15 gallons water to treat 1,500 sq. ft. of lawn. Treat lawn and water well 2 to 3 days before treatment. Do not mow lawn or early evening. Do not water lawn for 1 to 2 days following treatment.
