GENERAL DIRECTIONS

Ortho Yard & Patio Insect Spray is a fast-acting, effective flying insecticide that controls a wide variety of insects outside and inside the home. Refer to the table below for detailed directions. Repeat applications as recommended.

Mix 4 teaspoonfuls ORTHO Yard & Patio Insect Spray in 1 gallon water, unless otherwise specified. For best results use an ORTHO SPRAYETTE Garden Hose Sprayer.

Apply as a coarse spray or with a paint brush to window sills, baseboards under sinks, stove and refrigerator and other areas frequented by pests. Avoid contamination of food, dishes, utensils and water.
Lawns	Lawn Moth Larvae, Sod Webworms, Armyworms, Leafhoppers, Clover Mites, Thrips, Ants, Brown Dog Ticks	One cup (8 fl. oz.) in 15 gals. water to treat 1,000 sq. ft. of lawn. Mow lawn and water well 1 to 2 days before treatment. Treat lawn in afternoon or early evening. Do not water lawn for 2 to 3 days following treatment.
