Label amendments as per the GDE dated August 6, 1999.

Dear Ms. Kendrick:

The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable provided that you make the labeling change indicated below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

- 1. Align the percentage of carbaryl so that it is directly over the percentage of the other ingredients on the alternate text (Bag & Canister) label.
- 2. Delete the statement "May be used up to harvest unless otherwise noted" on the first page of the label. Delete the statement "This garden dust can be used on home garden fruits and vegetables up to the day of harvest unless otherwise noted" on the alternate text label.
- 3. Add the correct PHI for field and pop corn for the grain and fodder portion (48 days). In the alternate text portion of the label specify if the "corn" is sweet or field or pop corn and enter the correct PHI associated with the type of corn.
- 4. Correct the PHI for eggplant (3) and tomatoes (3) on the primary label and for tomatoes on the alternate text.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records. Submit two copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.
