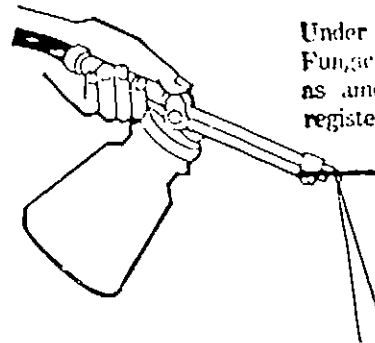

Do not allow children or pets to play on lawn for 24 hours after treatment. Stay off treated area for 24 hours. Protective clothing should be worn during periods of exposure, such as during application.

ORTHO DYRENE Lawn Disease Control gives effective control of common lawn diseases including Brown Patch (Rhizoctonia), Dollar Spot (Sclerotinia), Copper Spot (Glomerocarpal Rust (Puccinia), Snow Mold (Typhula) and Helminthosporium diseases such as Melting Out, Leaf Spot and Zebra Eye Spot. Make new dilution for each use.

FOR BEST RESULTS USE AN ORTHO SPRAYETTE

DIRECTIONS

Use ORTHO SPRAYETTE to apply treatments. Add the required amount of ORTHO DYRENE Lawn Disease Control to the sprayer jar and add a small amount of water. Mix until thin paste is formed, add water to bring to desired level and stir. Apply spray evenly. 6 gallons diluted spray treats 1,000 square feet. Repeat jar occasionally while spraying. Water lawn if necessary before applying ORTHO DYRENE Lawn Disease Control. Do not water lawn for 48 hours after application. Do not graze treated areas. Do not feed clippings to livestock.

PREVENTIVE PROGRAM: Begin applications in the spring before diseases appear, repeat every 10 to 14 days. During periods of very wet or damp weather, apply every 7 days. On new lawns, begin treatments as soon as first seeds germinate and repeat every 10 days until lawn is established.

CURATIVE PROGRAM: If disease is already established, use curative rate of ORTHO DYRENE Lawn Disease Control as outlined in Dilution Table. Make at least 3 successive applications at 7 day intervals until grass has recovered. Re-seed areas destroyed by disease. Continue treatments using PREVENTIVE PROGRAM.

SNOW MOLD PROGRAM: Apply after the first killing frost in the fall. A second application should be made when the lawn or other turfgrass area is free of snow in mid-winter. Apply a third application after the final melting of snow in late winter or early spring.

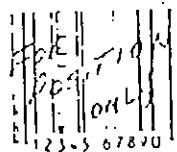
STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Store: Keep pesticide in original container. Do not put concentrate or dilute into food or drink containers. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Store in a cool, dry place, preferably in a locked storage area. Do not store diluted spray.

Disposal: Empty container: Partially filled bottle may be disposed of by securely wrapping original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash container. Do not reuse empty bottle. Rinse thoroughly before discarding in trash.
