

## PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

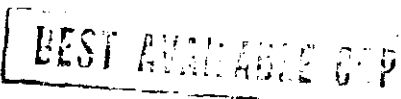
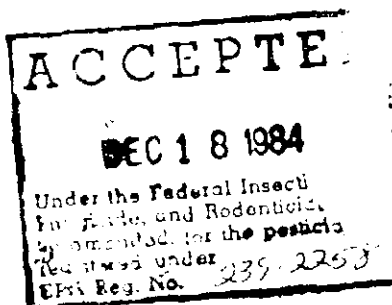

#### DIRECTIONS

This material is especially formulated for potato seed piece treatment.

**POTATO SEED PIECES:** To Control Black Leg, Seed Rot and Damp-Off, and Brown Eye Disease—Dust at 10 ounces per bushel of cut seed pieces (1 lb. per 100 lbs. of cut seed pieces). Apply in convenient container or by duster attachment over belt. Cut pieces should be treated within 6 hours of cutting. If planting is to be delayed more than 1 or 2 days the treated pieces should be stored for 2 to 3 days in open crates before bagging. Seed piece treatment only. Do not use treated seed pieces for food or feed purposes.
