DIRECTIONS

Apply in spring as evergreen and shrub growth begins and before weeds sprout. For best results, follow these directions carefully:

1. Before applying remove all existing broadleaf and grassy weeds since product kills sprouting seeds, not established weeds.
2. Punch handy perforations under pull-tape on top for easy spreading, or pour from spout into smaller container for spreading.
3. Spread ORTHO ORNAMENTAL WEED AND FEED evenly. Avoid missing small areas since weeds will grow in spots not covered. Working product into soil lightly gives maximum weed control and fertilizer activity.
4. Contents of this package covers 360 sq. ft. of soil area. A second application should be made 4 weeks later for continued weed control.
5. After application, sprinkle shrubs lightly with water to remove any of the product from foliage.

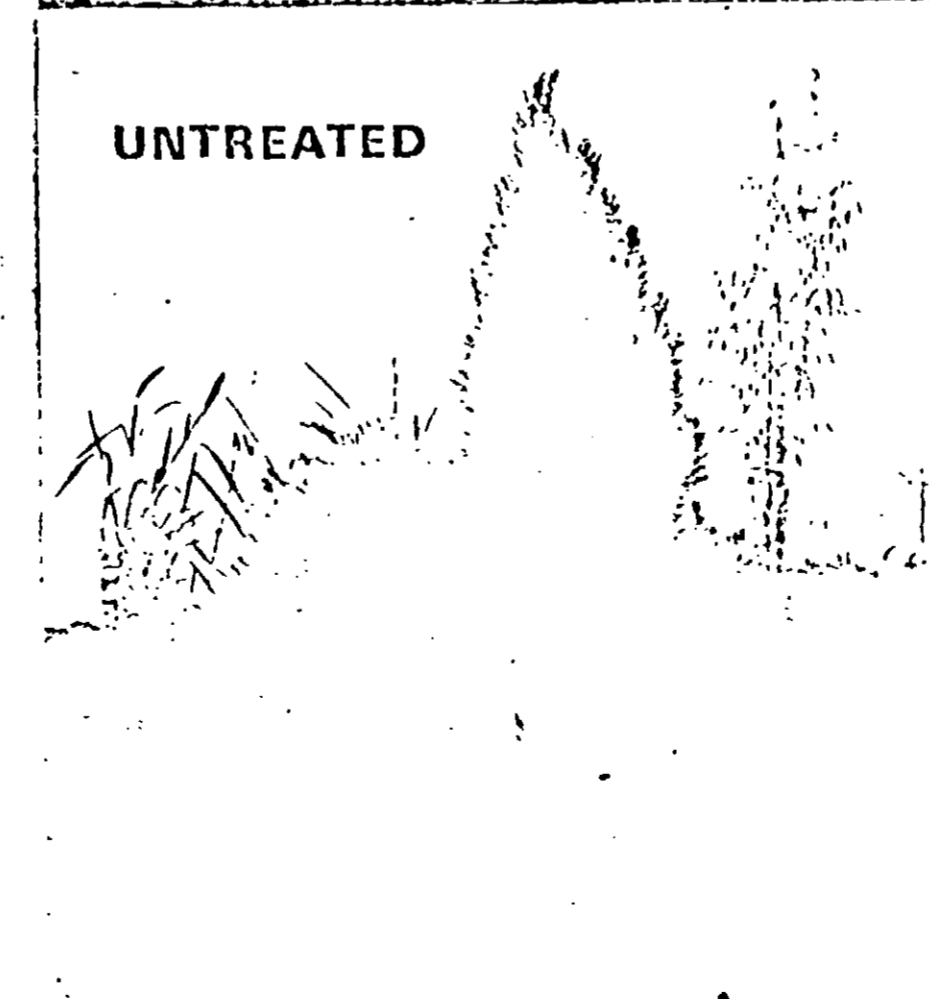
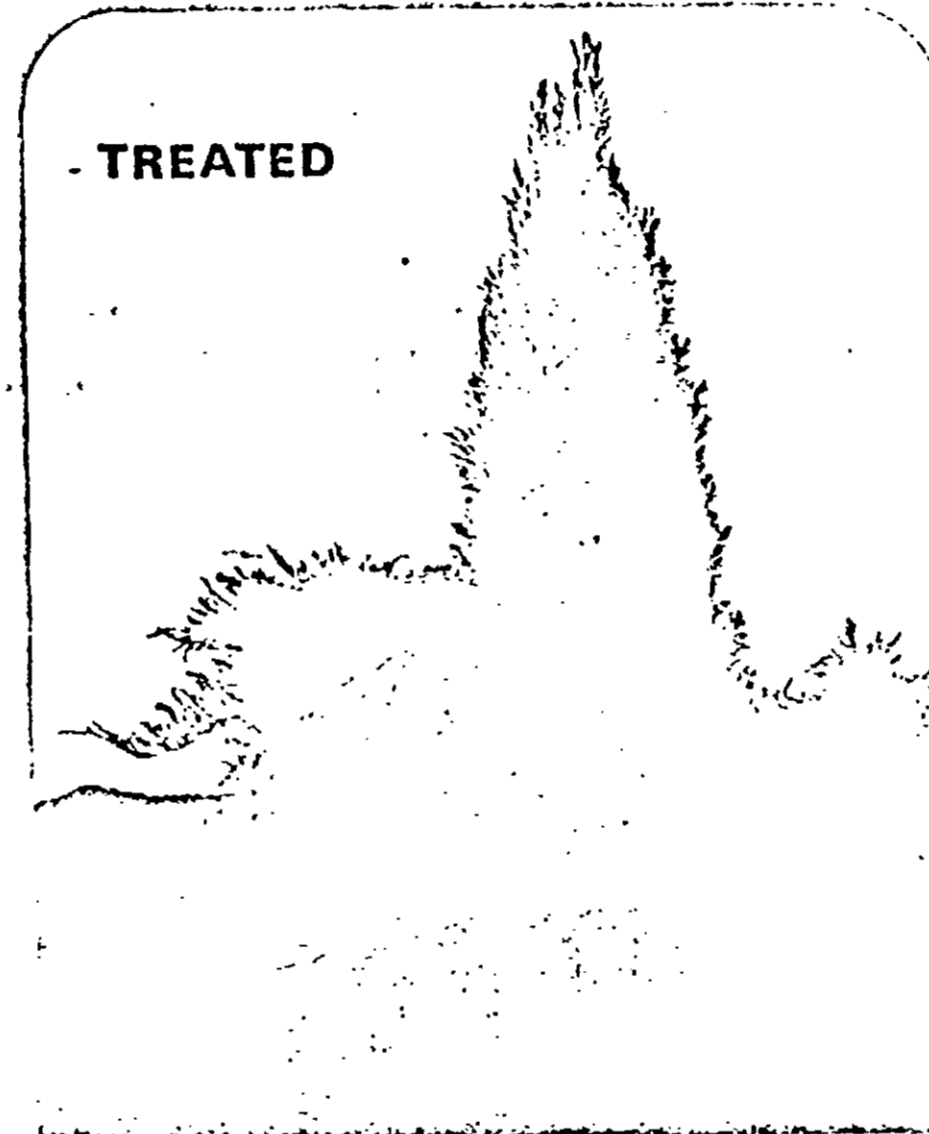
