ORTHO Sod Webworm Spray containing Lindane is designed for the control of Sod Webworms and other insects that infest lawns. It may be applied effectively with the ORTHO Lawn Sprayer.

Sod Webworms are light brown caterpillars, $\frac{1}{4}$ to $\frac{3}{4}$ inch long, that hide in the grass during the day and feed on the grass blades at night. Adult Webworms, usually referred to as Lawn Moths (about one inch in length with long shout), emerge from the grass at dusk. They fly over the lawn laying eggs that later hatch into destructive caterpillars

Sod Webworm damage appears first as small brown spots which may rapidly develop into large brown areas of severely damaged or destroyed grass.

DIRECTIONS

Treat lawns at first sign of insect infestation. Repeat as necessary. Do not store diluted spray. Make new dilution for each use.

PREVENTION: To prevent damage from occurring, spray the lawn as directed monthly throughout the summer starting in late tune.

CONTROL: If Lawn Moths (Sod Webworm Adults) are noticed in large numbers at dusk or at first sign of damage to lawn, treat as directed in following table. Repeat at monthly intervals throughout the summer

HOW TO APPLY

Place required amount of product for 1,000 square feet (20' x 50') in the ORTHO Lawn Sprayer jar. (See table above for details). Fill remainder of jar with water. Apply evenly to 1,000 square feet of lawn.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Induce vomiting if swallowed. Avoid breathing spray mist. May be absorbed through skin. Avoid skin contact. In case of skin contact, wash immediately with soap and water. Avoid contamination of feed and foodstuffs. Do not use on household pets or humans. Keep children and pets off treated areas until this material is washed into the soil and grass is dry. DO NOT USE. POUR, SPILL CR STORE NEAR HEAT OR OPEN FLAME. 
