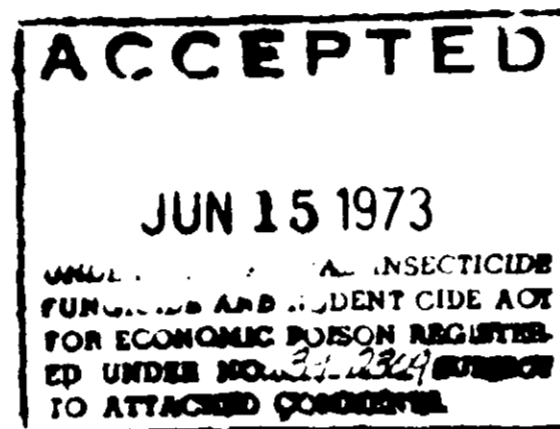

**PEACHES, NECTARINES:** Brown Rot, Peach Scab - 50 to 60 lbs. per acre. Make 2 to 3 prebloom applications. Repeat at petal fall and 3 to 4 covers as necessary. **Fruit Decay (Brown Rot, Rhizopus Rot)** - 65 lbs. per acre. Apply 18 days, 10 days and 1 day prior to harvest. Do not apply within 1 day of harvest to peaches or nectarines.

**SWEET CHERRIES:** Cherry Leaf Spot, Brown Rot - 50 to 60 lbs. per acre. Apply at popcorn, blossom and petal fall stages, continuing at 10 to 14-day intervals. **Fruit Decay (Brown Rot, Rhizopus Rot)** - 60 lbs. per acre. Apply 10 days and 1 day prior to harvest. Do not apply to Cherries within 1 day of harvest.

### ORNAMENTAL CROPS

**ROSES, HYDRANGEA:** Blight (Botrytis) - 30 lbs. per acre. **Field:** Apply prior to shipment or storage. **Stored Areas:** Thoroughly dust storage area and foliage and shed foliage; repeat application during long storage periods.

**CHRYSANTHEMUM, GERANIUM, ROSES:** Blight (Botrytis) - 30 lbs. per acre. Apply at first sign of disease to give even coverage of upper and lower leaf surfaces. Repeat at 7 to 10-day intervals.

**GLADIOLUS:** Dry Rot (Stromatinia) - Soil - 250 lbs. per 14,520 linear feet of furrow. Dust into furrow at planting time, so treated soil surrounds corms. **Foliage** - 30 lbs. per acre, dust thoroughly to insure coverage between spikes. Apply to bunched flower spikes after harvest and before shipment or storage.

**COMPATIBILITY:** Do not use this product on foliage immediately following oil sprays.
