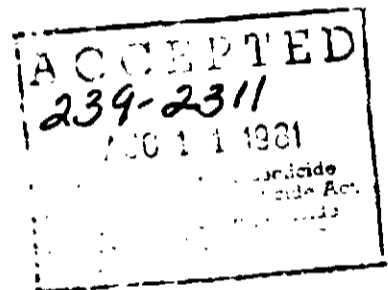
DIRECTIONS

STRAWBERRIES: Botrytis Rot, Red Spider Mites, Aphids, Spittle Bug, Twospotted Mite, Pacific Mite--40 to 50 lbs. per acre. Make first application when new growth starts in spring before fruit starts to form. Repeat application weekly. Do not use within 4 days of harvest.

COMPATIBILITY: Do not use this product on foliage closely following air sprays.

Maximize metal dust equipment, clean equipment after use. Do not apply under conditions involving possible drift to food, forage or other plantings that might be damaged or the crops thereof rendered unfit for sale, use or consumption.
