 ORTHO Brush Killer A can be applied diluted in water
 or undiluted (see directions). Do not store diluted spray

DIRECTIONS

FOLIAGE SPRAY: For effective control of woody plants,
 such as Poison Ivy and Poison Oak. Apply 1½ pints (3
 cups) ORTHO Brush Killer A in 1 gal. water to thoroughly
 wet all leaves, stems and suckers to the ground line. Use
 this application method only when leaves are present on
 plant. For best results, spray during periods of high
 humidity. Some regrowth may be expected on resistant
 species such as Ash, Maple, Oak and Hickory. Repeat
 treatment to kill regrowth. **Avoid drift to desirable plants.**

STUMP KILLING: To prevent stumps from resprouting,
 treat the entire stump, particularly the cut surface and
 exposed roots with **undiluted** ORTHO Brush Killer A. It
 can be applied anytime of year but, for best results,
 apply as soon as possible after trees are cut. Paint or
 daub **undiluted** over entire stump.

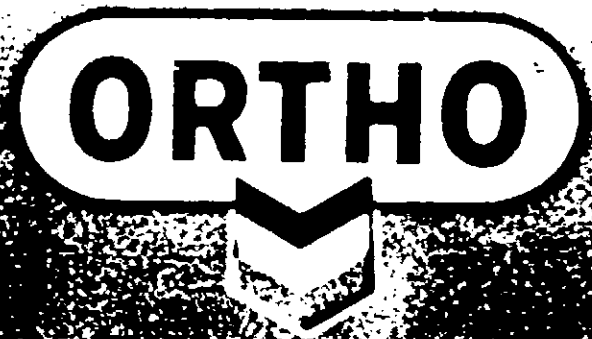
FRILL METHOD: Make frill by using an axe to cut over-
 lapping notches in a continuous ring around the tree
 trunk near its base. Cut through the bark but do not
 remove the chips. This method is recommended for trees
 6 inches in diameter and larger (trees too large to foliage
 spray). Pour in as much undiluted ORTHO Brush Killer
 A as the frill will hold. Hard-to-kill woody plants, such
 as Beech, Hickory and Sweet Gum may require a second
 treatment.

IMPORTANT: ORTHO Brush Killer A is non selective; do
 not apply to, or drain or flush equipment on desirable
 plants or vegetation, as injury may result. Do not drain
 or flush equipment near domestic waters. **Wash sprayer
 thoroughly after use to remove all herbicidal solution
