WHEN AND HOW MUCH TO APPLY

Spring Seeded Lawns or Bare Spots in Established Lawns: Apply anytime in the spring before crab grass emerges. Spread contents of this pack over 100' x 100' of lawn. To extend control, make a second application 4 to 6 weeks later. Provide water to insure germination of new grass seed.

IMPORTANT APPLICATION TIPS

Apply application evenly over lawn. Do not apply to wet grass. To prevent drift, do not apply on windy days. Do not apply to lawns with weeds, ivy, and the like. Do not apply to lawns with Bermuda grass, St. Augustine grass, or any other grasses. Do not apply to lawns with other plants.

To insure the best germination of new grass seed, prepare lawn before planting and provide sufficient water after watering and treatment with ORTHO Spring Seeding Crab Grass Control plus Lawn Food. No reseeding is planned within 4 months after application. For more effective control of crab grass as well as control of a wide range of other weeds, such as Poa Annua (Annual Bluegrass), Goosegrass, Watergrass (Barnyardgrass), Lambsquarters, Redroot Pigweed, Deadnettle and Shepherds-purse can be obtained by using ORTHO GRO Crab Grass Control Plus Post-Seed Fertilizer.

ORTHO WHIRLYBIRD SPREADER
Newly-Seeded Lawns or Bare Spots: Use WHIRLYBIRD Setting No. 2. Apply 2 WHIRLYBIRDS full (5 1/2 lbs) over 1600 sq. ft. (40' x 40'). Spread in a criss-cross pattern by applying the second WHIRLYBIRD full at right angles to the first. Start cranking WHIRLYBIRD handle before depressing thumb lever.
Established Lawns: Use WHIRLYBIRD Setting No. 3. Apply 2 WHIRLYBIRDS full (5 1/2 lbs) over 800 sq. ft. (20' x 40'). Spread in a criss-cross pattern by applying second WHIRLYBIRD full at right angles to the first.
