Exposure during these operations can be reduced by wearing a long sleeve shirt, long pants and gloves.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If in eyes, wash eyes for at least 15 minutes and see a doctor. For skin contact, wash immediately with soap and water. See a doctor if irritation occurs or rash develops. If swallowed, give water or milk to drink and telephone for medical advice. Consult medical personnel before inducing vomiting. If medical advice cannot be obtained, then take person to product container to the nearest medical emergency treatment center or hospital. If inhaled, remove person from exposure area.

Wear mid-forearm to elbow length chemical resistant gloves, full body clothing during handling and application.

USE PRECAUTION

When using formulations that do not contain dye, to comply with 21 CFR Chapter 1, Section 2.25, all seed treated with a pesticide must be colored to distinguish and prevent subsequent inadvertent use as a food for man or feed for animals.

SHAKE, ROLL OR AGITATE CONTAINER TO IMPROVE UNIFORMITY.

For use in slurry treaters. Do not allow mixture to stand overnight. Clean out equipment thoroughly between treating operations.

COTTON:

Acid delinted..... 3 fl. oz./100 lbs.
Machine delinted..... 4 1/2 fl. oz./100 lbs.

RICE: use 4 to 6 fl. oz. per 100 lbs. of dry seed to help in the control of seed rots and seedling diseases such as *Actinomyces*, *Pythium* and *Helminthosporium*. Best results are obtained by treating seeds prior to pre-soaking when planting in flooded fields.

Do not use treated seed for human consumption. Seeds treated with DIFOLATAN 4 Flowable Seed Protectant, sold or shipped as feed or foodstuffs, may be considered adulterated under state and federal laws. Treated seed should be labeled as follows: "TREATED SEED. DO NOT USE FOR FOOD, FEED OR OIL."
