DIRECTIONS

SHAKE BEFORE USING. Point valve opening away from face and push button, holding container as upright as possible. Do not remain in treated areas and ventilate the area after treatment is completed.

NOTE: Do not contaminate food, utensils, dishes or drinking water. Foods should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment. Cleanly cleaned before using. When using the product in these areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not spray on furniture.

FLIES, MOSQUITOES, GNATS: As a room spray to control these insects — shut doors and windows, press valve and direct spray to all parts of room, especially the base corners and other areas, filling the room with mist. Keep about 3 feet from walls, fabric and furniture. Also spray areas where pests may tend to congregate—along walls, baseboards, cracks in woodwork, and other areas. Keep room closed for at least 15 minutes after treatment. Air room before occupancy. Repeat as necessary.

ANTS, ROACHES, FLEAS, SPIDERS, EARWIGS, COWBUGS, CENTIPEDES: Spray directly on insects. Also spray under sinks, under boards, cabinets, cracks and crevices, base boards, pine, wood, door sills, window frames, cracks, garbage cans, firewood piles, refuse areas, in attics, behind shelving, bookcases, storage areas, floor coverings and other areas where pests may be found. For ant control, spray trails, nests and points of entry. Repeat as necessary.

ANIMAL PESTS — DOG, CATS: Fleas — Apply directly to animals along back, under forelegs and on other areas. Part hair to contact skin and insure good coverage. Hold nozzle about one foot away while spraying. Apply until hair is thoroughly moist. Do not directly spray in eyes, ears or mouth of animal. To reduce reinfestation, thoroughly spray the animals bedding and other resting areas. Treat these areas at the rate of two seconds per linear foot while spraying at a distance of 12 to 18 inches. Also spray entire inside surface of dog houses. Repeat as necessary.

WASPS: Application should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Spray liberally into hiding and breeding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.

INDOORS — FOR PROTECTION OF WOOLENS: Apply only to garments, blankets, carpets, and other woolen fabrics before placing in storage for protection from larvae of webbing clothing moths and black carpet beetles.

Dry clean or wash garments and blankets before treating. Clean carpets, draperies and other fabrics by thoroughly brushing before treating.

Hold the container 14 inches to 18 inches from the fabric and apply the spray while moving evenly in a forward and back motion across the fabric while covering one foot per second. Spray the entire fabric surface until it is slightly moist or damp to the touch. When possible treat both sides of the fabric. Do not soak or wet fabric. For maximum protection place treated fabrics after drying in plastic or paper bags. Also treat cracks and crevices of closets, chests and trunks where these fabrics are being stored. Treat the cracks and crevices at the rate of two seconds per linear foot.

When applied as directed on fabric and in storage areas this treatment will offer protection for 6 months. To insure protection inspect the fabric in the storage area once every three months. Repeat application only when necessary. Avoid heavy applications. When possible make application outdoors. If application is made indoors do not remain in treated areas. Ventilate the area after treatment is complete.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a secure, preferably locked storage area away from heat or open flame

DISPOSAL: PRODUCT—Unused product may be disposed of by securely wrapping original container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. **CONTAINER—**Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
