

tact skin and insure good coverage. Hold nozzle about one foot away while spraying. Apply until hair is thoroughly moist. Do not directly spray in eyes, ears of mouth of animal. To reduce reinfestation, thoroughly thray the arishuls headling and other resting areas. Treat these areas at the rate of two seconds per linear foot while spraying at a distance of 12 to 18 inches. Also spray entire inside surface of dog houses. Repeat as necessary.
